2) Workshop on Data Science

Date - September 1- November 3, 2018

Aiming to provide a rigorous learning of mathematics in a hands-on manner, a Workshop on Data Science was conducted by Radian-ce, The Mathematics Society of Janki Devi Memorial College in collaboration with JDMC Alumnae Association for the students of second and third years. Astha Jagia (alumna), Credit Risk Analyst in RBS and Sanskriti Jain, Analyst in Spectra Net were the trainers for the workshop. It focused on the concepts of Advanced Excel (V lookup, pivot table Mid Function) and R Programming (data manipulation, data importing, regression).

Two hour sessions were conducted on every Saturday for two months. Home assignments were given after the completion of each topic to help students achieve excellence and command of the topics. Minimum of 85% attendance was mandatory for the students to receive a certificate of completion.

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3) Consumer Capability Workshop

Date – October 25, 2018

JDMC, Alumnae Association organised One Day Workshop on "Consumer Capability" on 25th October 2018 in the college. The workshop was designed and conducted by our alumna, Dr. Jayashree Pillai (Associate Professor, Miranda House, University of Delhi). Dr. Pillai specialises in Public Administrations and Management, Indian Political System and Governance, Consumer Affairs, Child Labour and Environment and Women Issues.

More than 100 students from various streams attended the workshop. Faculty members also benefitted from the session. Dr Pillai explained how to exercise the consumer rights through real life examples. The whole session was quite interactive and fruitful for the audience.
