OBJECTIVE


The competition tested the overall knowledge of the participants on all topics related to the accomplishments that women are receiving in different sectors of our country.

Priya Thakur, B.A. (Hons.) Economics I Year secured the highest score and was announced the winner of the quiz competition.






• Webinar on: Emerging Careers after the Pandemic
