Report PARENTS' INDUCTION PROGRAMMME 18TH and 19TH January 2021



The session on 18th January 2021 included parents of students of BA(Prog.), BA (Hons) English, BA (Hons) History, BA (Hons) Hindi and BA (Hons) Sociology. 


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












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
