The webinar featured the esteemed speaker, Dr. Madhu Babu Bejjam.

Dr. MADHU BABU BEJJAM, a highly respected expert in the field, has made significant contributions to patent and design filing. With over 7 years of experience in the Indian Patent Office under the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India, he currently serves as the Assistant Controller of Patents & Designs at RGNIIPM Nagpur. Dr. BEJJAM holds a Ph.D. from CSIR-IICT and received a doctorate from ACSIR. His role involves examining and handling national and international patent applications filed across various Patent offices in India. He has also authored in more than 15 international journals, including publications with the Royal Society of Chemistry. Dr. BEJJAM has delivered numerous lectures on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) across different regions of the country.

The webinar focused on several key topics, including the importance of patenting, censorship, and intellectual property rights. Dr. Bejjam commenced by explaining the distinction between invention and discovery, clarifying that while an invention can be patented, a discovery cannot. He guided the attendees through the historical evolution of patenting, providing insights into the patenting process in India and its evolution over time. Additionally, he delved into the concept of censorship and how it is implemented.

The webinar garnered a significant attendance of faculty members from the two colleges and 131 students from JDMC and many students from MGGC.

Traditional Paris convention vs. PCT system



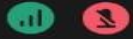

Turmeric:

In 1995, two non resident Indians at the University of Mississippi Medical Centre, Jackson, (Suman K.Das and Hari Har P.Cohly) were granted US patent number 54015041) for turmeric to be used for healing wounds.

CSIR challenged the patent on the grounds of "prior art", i.e. existing public knowledge . The claim had to be backed by written documentation claiming traditional wisdom. CSIR submitted a document proof in the form of research paper published in 1953 in the Journal of the Indian Medical Association. The US Patent Office upheld the objection and cancelled the patent in 1997
