


National Webinar on the topic

"Encryption and Decryption using RSA Algorithm in Signed Graph Structures "




Pi day - 14th March, 2023



Career Opportunities in Mathematics



At the end, students asked their queries which were taken care by Dr. Pooja Punyani. It turned out to be an interactive and informative session. Around 60 students attended.




Departmental Elections for the Post of General Secretary (2022-23)

Orientation Program - II








Workshop on MS Word, MS PowerPoint and MS Excel-Level 2

Eventually, the joy of giving week unfurled our inner joy that arouses when we do something for others selflessly.






Online Workshop under the aegis of IQAC on the topic MS Word, MS PowerPoint and MS Excel
