### **Brief report -**

The Department of Philosophy, Janki Devi Memorial College organized a movie screening event for the students, showcasing the critically acclaimed film "Ship of Theseus" (2011) on 24th June, 2023. The film, directed by Anand Gandhi, revolves around the philosophical concept of identity and explores the moral choices individuals face in their lives. About an hour into the film, attendees were provided with the 10 minute break to rejuvenate themselves.

After the completion of the movie, Fiona Sarkar resumed the stage to deliver her interpretation of the film's moral and philosophical implications. She shared her insights on how the movie's narrative reflected real-life dilemmas and the importance of introspection in making ethical decisions. The floor was then opened for other students to express their views and engage in a discussion.

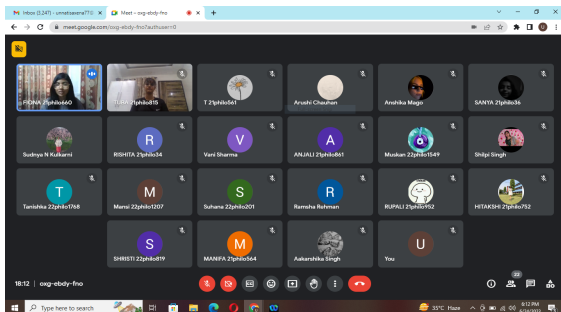

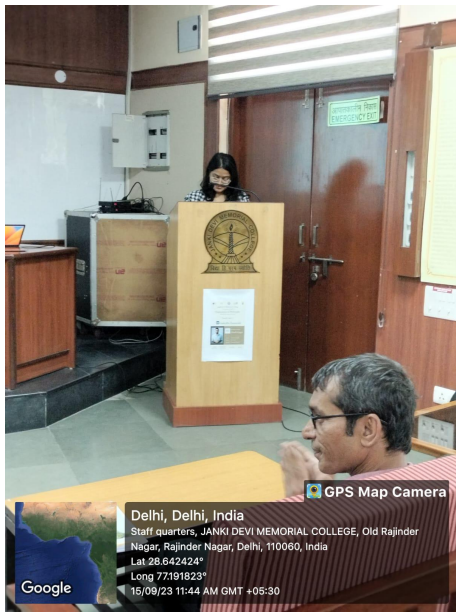
