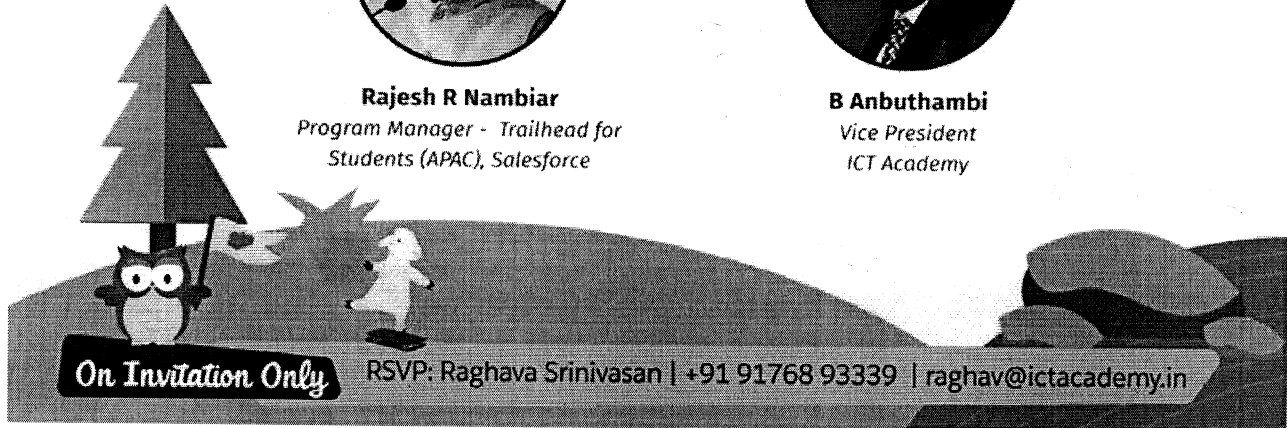

With mutual agreement, member institution has to submit a fresh request to host the event with updated details.
7. Host Institution needs to take care of the local transportation and food / refreshment of the guest / trainer.
