


Euphonie: The Western Music Society




3 EUPHONIE DEDICATES MILLION DREAMS TO DR. SMITA MITRA

4 EUPHONIE ORIENTATION CEREMONY FOR BATCH OF 2021-22






5 EUPHONIE AUDITIONS, FORM AND LIVE ON ZOOM

Vocal Workshop: An online workshop of 8 sessions with Ms. Tsewang Diki Bhutiya; a performer and music teacher was organised between November and January for the members. These workshops gave the students a better understanding of their vocal ranges and made them mindful of pitch, tone, and scale. The training exercises helped strengthen their voices. She also helped the singers with multiple breathing exercises which helped them with their singing range and helped reduce stress and brought focus and concentration to their overall performance.


