

## PAINTING COMPETITION

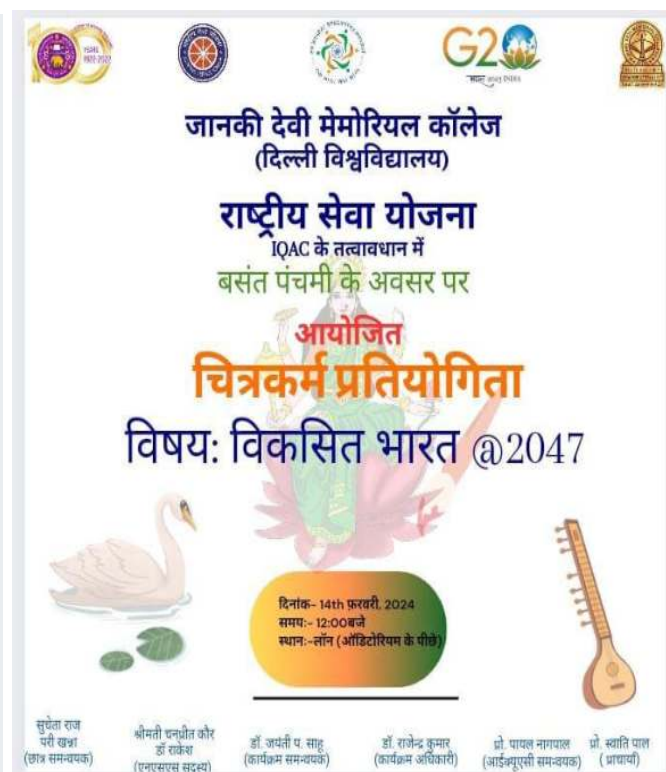

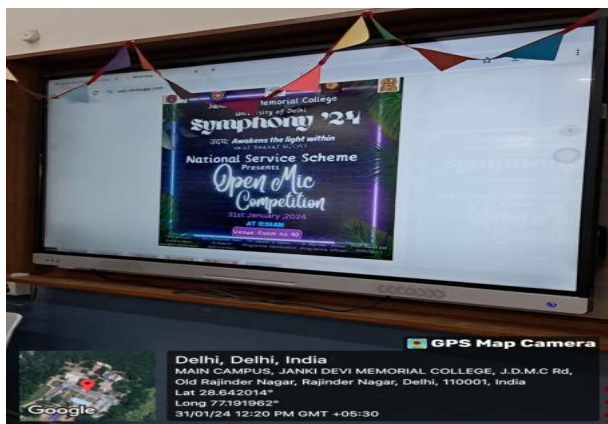
**Objective** - Showcasing creativity and expertise through engaging performances that captivate and inspire the audience at the talent event.

## VOTING DEMO WORKSHOP

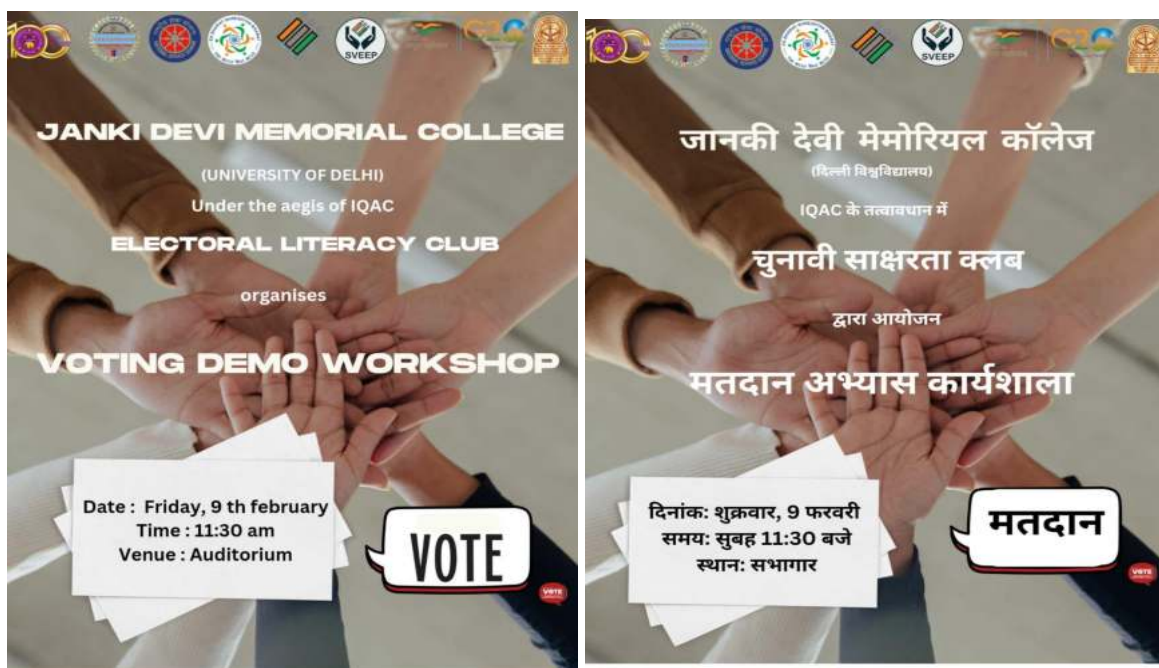

## PLEDGE TAKING CEREMONY

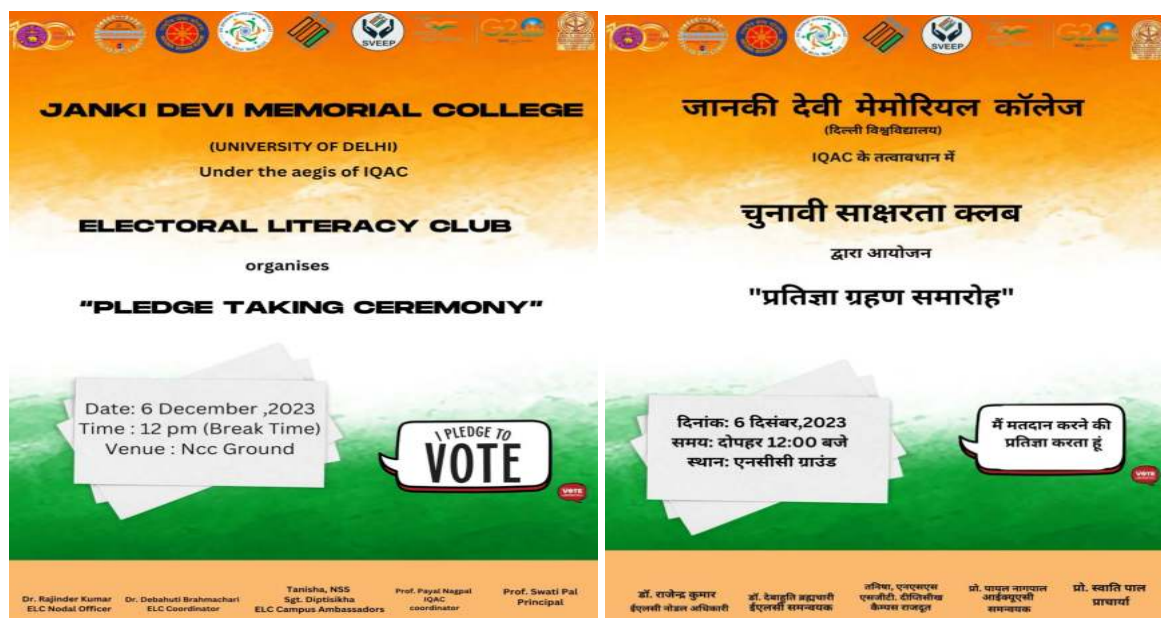
