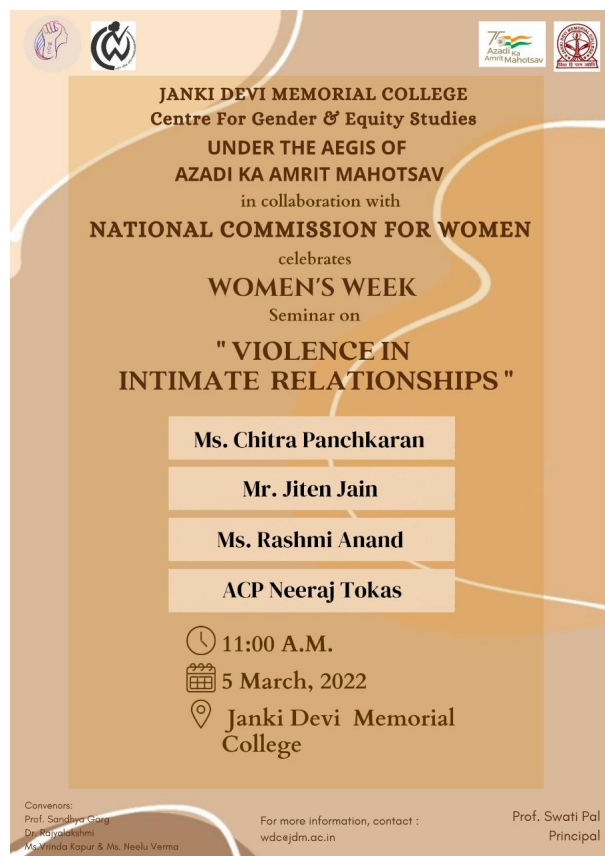

Poster of Seminar on "Violence in Intimate Relationships" held on 5 March 2022 as part of the Commemorative Event for Women's Day






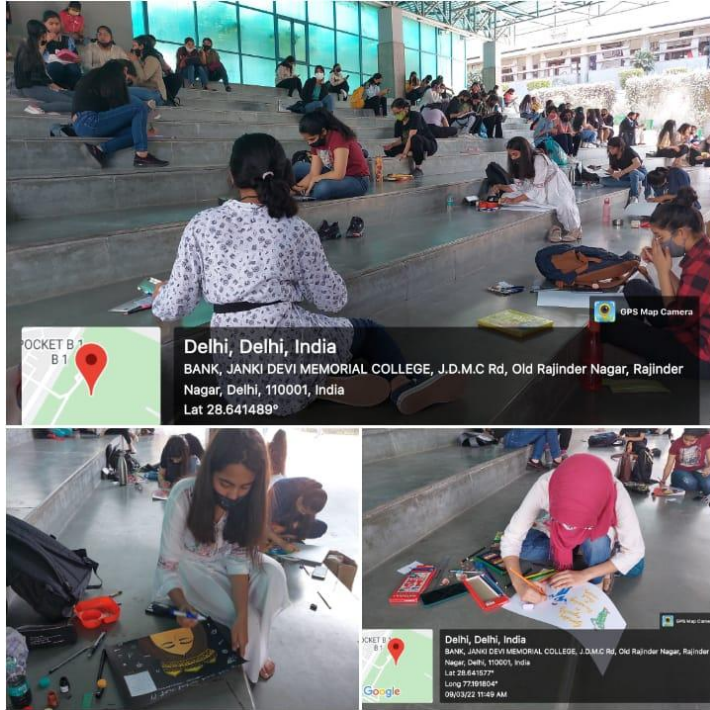

Poster for an Online Intra-College Poster Making Competition held in the month of October





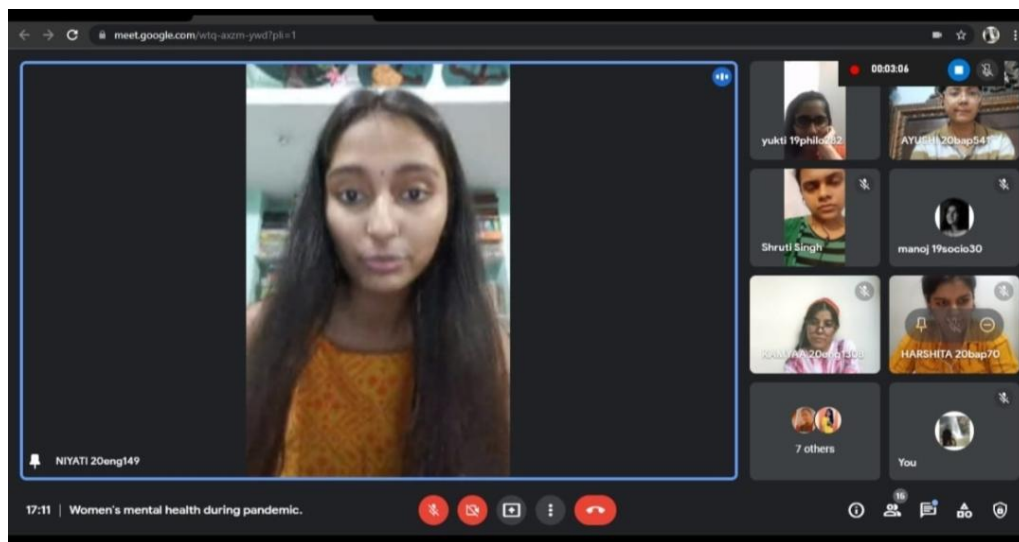

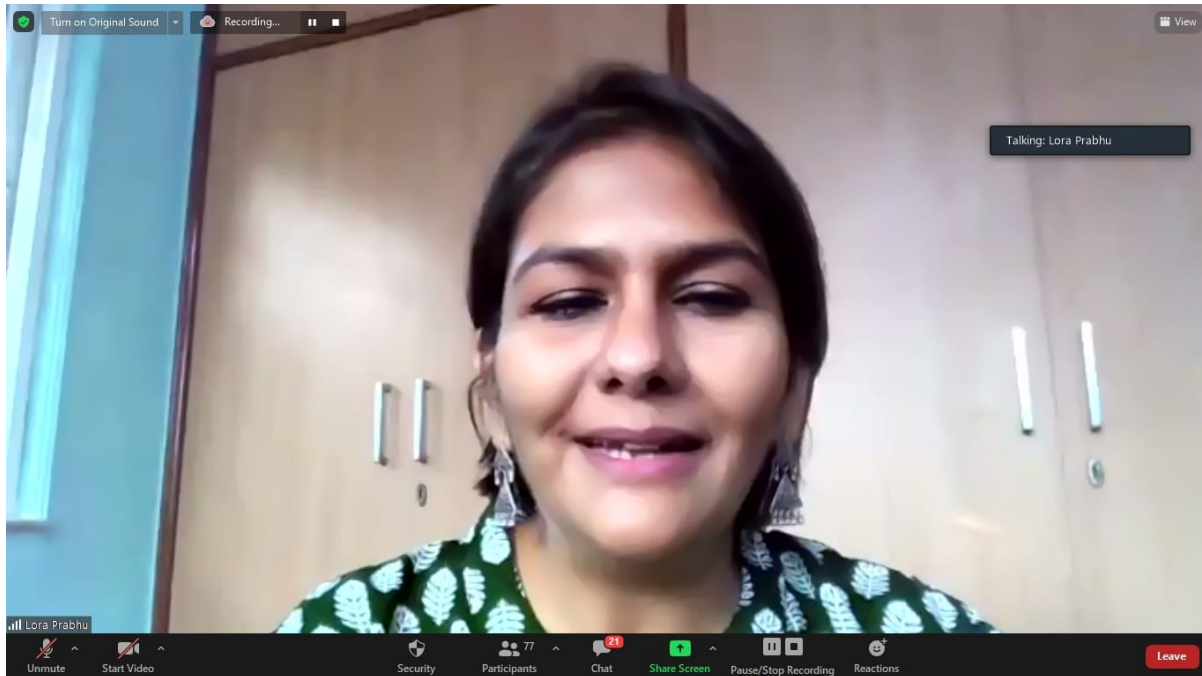

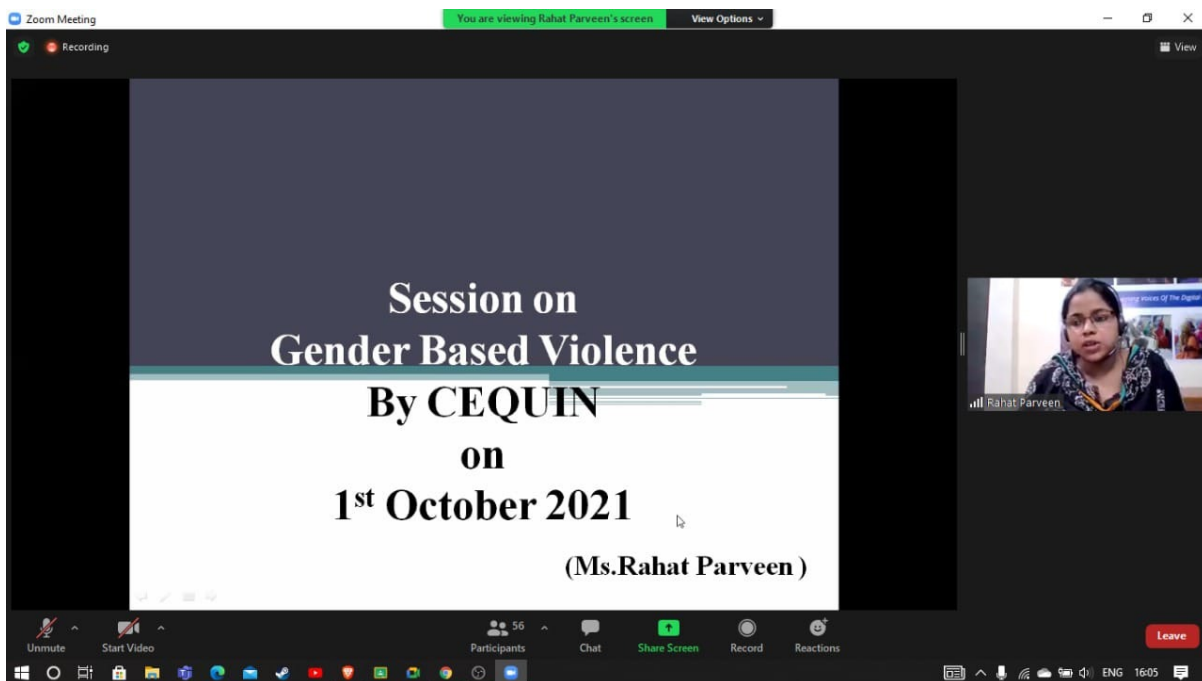

Poster of "11-Day Gender Sensitization Training Session" held from 24 September 2021 to 15 November 2021.



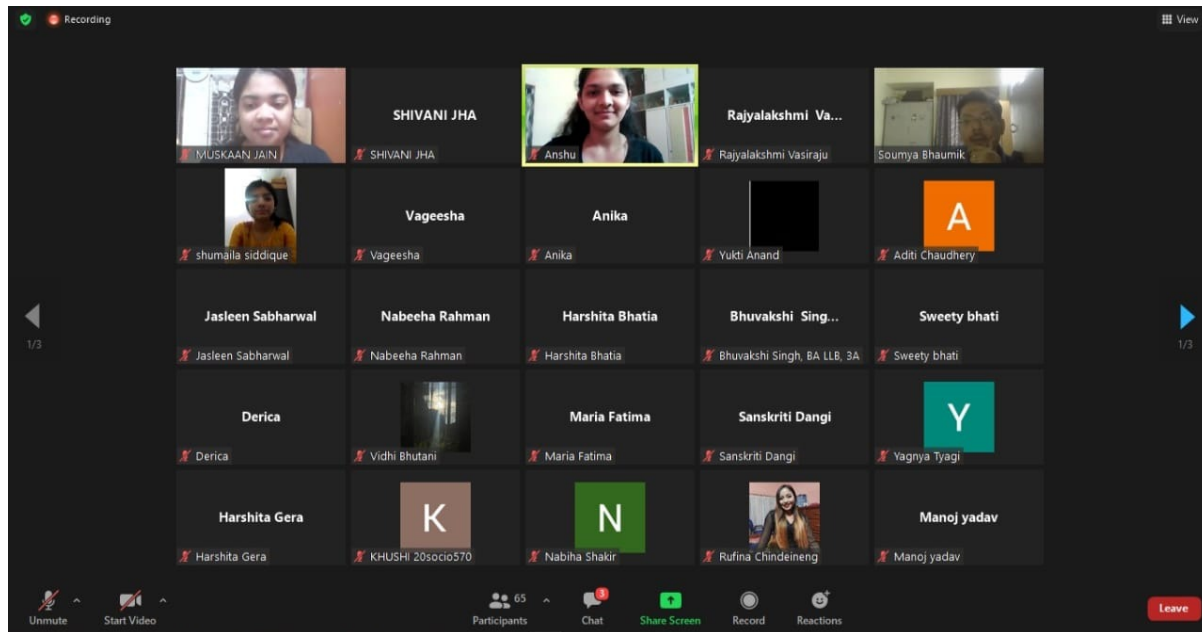

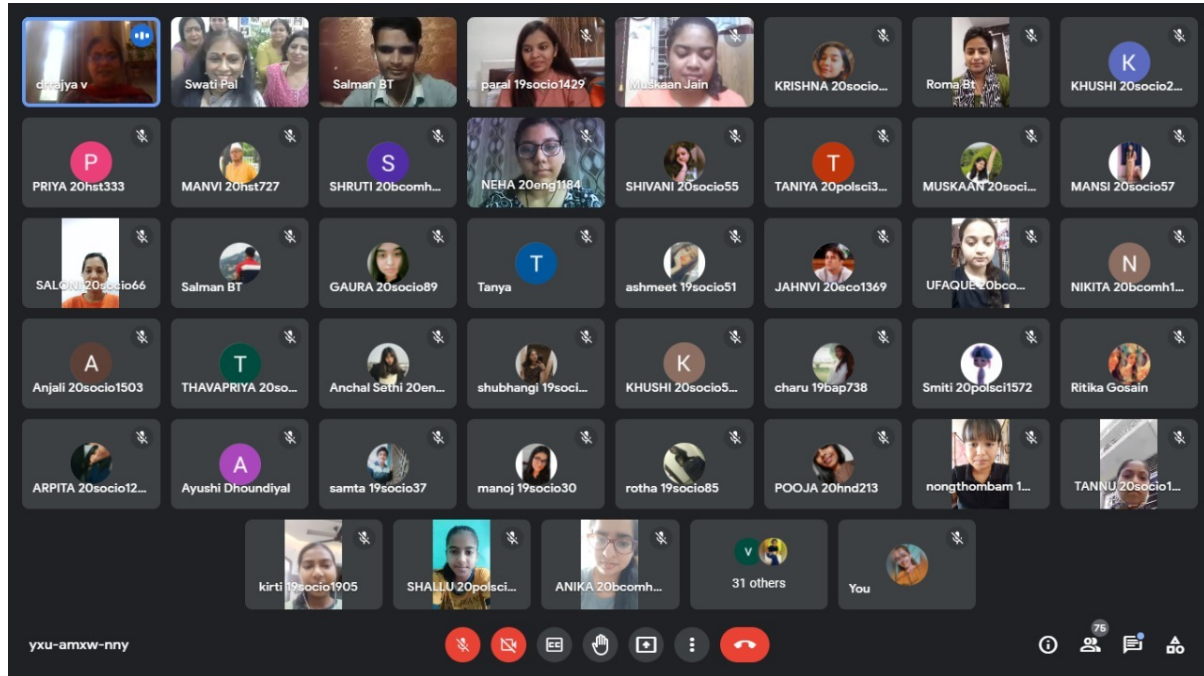
