Nominations are invited from the students for the 4 core posts of the Students' Union 2025-2026 as per the details and time schedule given below:

Eligibility Criterion for Nomination of Core Posts:

- 1. All bonafide students of the college of the respective year are eligible to file their nomination for different posts of JDMC Students' Union. The candidate should have cleared all their papers of the University of Delhi Examination.
- 2. The students should not have been held back from any examination in the last academic session due to shortage of attendance.
- 3. The candidates should have obtained at least 6.5 as SGPA (last semester examination held).

- 4. A student can fill nomination for maximum of 2 posts, else the form stands rejected if more than 2 is filled.
- 5. The final decision of the election committee will be binding.

Rules and Regulations for the Election:

- 1. Every nomination shall be submitted in the prescribed form and as per the eligibility criteria for the candidates specified above. Students should submit the copy of current year college ID-card and a copy of previous year mark sheet or copy of results.
- 2. The election is **paperless**. Only word of mouth and online canvassing for votes is allowed. (No pamphlets, osters and chit distribution is allowed.)
- 3. No candidate should use any party they may belong to, to canvas for votes as the JDMC Students' Union is **non-political** and **merit based.**
- 4. Any kind of maligning or slandering of a co-competitor, either verbal or in any other form during campaigning, will disqualify a student from standing for elections. Kindly maintain dignity and courtesy at all times.

- 5. There will be a secret ballot by all bonafide students of the college currently on rolls on Election Day.
- 6. Any candidate who breaks the rules will be disqualified from elections.
- 7. At any point, even post-election, if an elected candidate is found guilty of any of the aforementioned, the candidate will not be allowed to serve her term.
