





3) Samvaad - Alumna lecture Series-3

On the occasion of centenary celebrations, the Department of Mathematics, in collaboration with JDMC Alumnae Association organized a panel discussion series on “Mathematics: In All Walks of Life” on August 27th, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom, an online platform. The purpose of this session was to spread knowledge about the usage of Mathematics in the real world to the audience by giving an overview of the articles from ten different speakers that will be published in a book.

The session started with the welcome speech given by Ms Shubhangi, student Maths department after which Prof. Sandhya Garg, President, Alumnae Association and Vice Principal, JDMC addressed the gathering. This was followed by the warm words given by our dearest principal Prof. Swati Pal for everyone.

The first speaker Dr. Punita Sharma, Associate Professor Dept. of Sanskrit, Sri Venkateswara College informed us about the connection of Mathematics to one's inner self which then was carried forward by our second speaker Dr. Alka Marwaha, Associate Professor, Jesus and Mary College with her insightful knowledge. After this Dr. Vagisha Sharma, Associate Professor in Dept. of Mathematics, Indraprastha College for Women beautifully explained the use of Mathematics in various things by exemplifying some of them like symbols of AIIMS. The next speaker Dr. Mukta Jain, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Mathematics, PGDAV College told us how we can solve our real life problems using Algebra. Fifth speaker, Ms. Aparna Rajput, Researcher, depicted Mathematics as a life saver in different situations. Then, the sixth speaker Ms. Ankita Bhatt, Consultant, represented the use of Mathematics in corporates. Another speaker Ms. Aparna Nayyar, Consultant, expressed the use of mathematics in reading human behavior. The eighth speaker, Ms. Deepansi, Data Analyst, spread the knowledge about Mathematical application of data science and text summarization. Then Ms. Muskan Bansal, Entrepreneur, shared her views about the importance of compounding in startups. The last speaker, Miss Nikita, Research Assistant explained the importance of mathematics in Artificial Intelligence and also informed about the future scopes of mathematics.

Q & A session was held towards the end of the session as the chat box was flooded with questions which showed the audience's keen interest in the prior talk's. The questions basically wanted a detailed explanation of some things mentioned by the speakers and each of them delivered a highly intellectual lecture, though in short which were answered by our speakers.

At the very last, Dr. Sharda Sharma Gautam, Teacher-In-Charge, Dept. of Mathematics, delivered a formal vote of thanks to all the speakers and everyone present there including President and Vice President of alumnae association. She also appreciated the intellectuality of each speaker for bringing new, amazing and interesting concepts to this discussion. 5) Samvaad - Alumna lecture Series-5

On 23 November 2022, the Alumnae Association in collaboration with the Department of Political Science of Janki Devi Memorial College organised a panel discussion on 'Changing Dimensions of Women Empowerment'. The invited panelists were alumnae of the Political Science department.

This session was attended by Prof. Sandhya Garg (Vice Principal, JDMC and President of the Alumnae Association), Dr. Sharda Gautam (Vice President of Alumnae Association), Dr. Suman Gupta (TIC), Dr. Poonam Kanwal (Association In-charge) and other faculty and students of the department. Ms. Shalini Singh and Mr. Rohit Singh were Teacher Organisers of the event.

The event began with a welcoming speech presented by the Vice President, Medha Tushti, after which, Prof. Sandhya Garg welcomed the panelists and addressed the audience. In her speech, she laid emphasis on the improved economic condition of women and the hardships faced by them in professional and personal spaces. This was followed by Dr. Suman Gupta's address, where she talked about the strength associated with women.

In the panel discussion segment, each panelist was given a timeframe of 7 to 10 minutes. Reetika, alumna of batch of 2015, addressed the aspect of women entrepreneurship being the recent phenomenon. Anuradha, alumna of batch of 2017, who is a Ph.D. scholar at Jawaharlal Nehru University, emphasized upon 'Stree Shakti' is an integral part of 'Rashtra Shakti', she also highlighted the fact that the armed forces and other National Security forces are male dominated. Aparna, alumna of the 2010, is a lawyer in the High Court, talked about the status of women in law and policy-making bodies in India.

The panel discussion was succeeded by a questions-answer round, in which the students as well as faculty members participated actively.

The session ended with the vote of thanks extended by the Vice-Principal, Prof. Sandhya Garg.





Women Entrepreneurs: A Research Overview

- Do structural factors such as inheritance laws differentially affect males and females?
- Does variation in social networks of male and female entrepreneurs influence the ability to acquire resources for venture start-ups and growth?
- What is the influence of self-confidence on the likelihood of male and female entrepreneurial start-ups and growth?
- Do men and women perceive opportunities in the same way?
- In sum, women's entrepreneurship is a significant and growing phenomenon worldwide, yet research has not kept pace. In many countries, women comprise one-third of the population of entrepreneurs, but we know little about them. By including this population in our research, we will effectively know more about entrepreneurship in general.

6) Samvaad - Alumna lecture Series-6

On the occasion of completion of 100 years of the prestigious Delhi University, Janki Devi Memorial College has taken the initiative to organise a series of lectures by alumnae where former students along with the teachers converse about the issues of the day. This series is called Samvaad, and on 4th December, 2022 the English Department Association played host to a panel of alumnae with the topic “women and higher education” under discussion.

The meeting was attended by the Principal of the college, Professor Swati Pal, the vice principal, Prof. Sandhya Garg, members of the Alumna Association as well as faculty of the English Department. First Year students were also part of the meeting. Professor Sandhya Garg, an alumna of the college and President of the alumnae association gave the welcome address. The discussion was moderated by Dr. Sanjukta Naskar, member of the English Department.

The discussion began with a series of questions which sought to know about the views of the alumnae about the role of women in higher education.. The first question asked was, “what do you think could be the key areas which challenge the growth of women’s role in higher education?” Various answers were given to this; the alumni pointed out marriage, patriarchy and lack of family support to be the eminent challenges. Further they explained that the pressure to get married after graduating was a big hurdle, which if not they, their peers had to overcome.

The second question was, “Does higher education continue to be gendered in India?” Having gained a firsthand experience of this, the students agreed that yes, higher education is still gendered in India and the Bachelors’ degree just serves as a tool to fetch a better match and how families want an educated but not a working woman in marriage. Higher education is still portrayed as something not necessary and a woman is robbed of her individuality and has to exist as an obligation to her family.

The third question proceeded as, “How did your perspective about life change after college?” Self confident and mature as the alumnae are now, they discussed how they entered the college as restricted individuals and had low self esteem. They added how JDMC provided them a safe place for being in and expressing themselves as individuals that they are. JDMC gave them wings for the sky that waited outside for them.

The concluding question was, “What is the Role of higher education in women’s career choices?” The answer that followed was- Higher education opens new horizons for not only women but for everyone. However, it especially gives women the rightful place they deserve in society.

Professor Swati Pal then expressed her joy after seeing her former students and hearing them speaking with such confidence. She wished them all the best in their future endeavors. The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Jitender Gill.







8) Samvaad - Alumna lecture Series-8

The Economics Department in collaboration with Alumnae Association, organized a panel discussion on the topic 'Women And Economy' under the "Samvaad" series initiated by JDMC on the occasion of the ongoing Centenary celebrations of the University of Delhi on February 4, 2023 via zoom. The session was attended by the distinguished retired faculty members, faculty and students of the Economics department.

The discussion aimed to shed light on the role of women in the economy and discuss the challenges faced by women in the workplaces. The panel consisted of ten distinguished alumni who shared their experiences and offered insights on the topic.

The discussion started with the welcome address by Dr. Shilpa Choudhary, Teacher-in-charge, Economics Department and IQAC coordinator, JDMC which was followed by a brief introduction of the panelists, who represented a diverse range of industries and career paths.

Our respected Principal Prof. Swati Pal addressed the gathering. Ma'am welcomed all the alumni and extended an invite to them for the Alumni meet being organized by the college on 11 February, 2023. Ma'am also expressed her thoughts on the topic Women and Economy and explained how savings are crucial in financial planning of every household and how women can contribute to it.

Professor Sandhya Garg, President, Alumni Association and Vice Principal, JDMC also extended gratitude to all the panelist on board to join the discussion and interact with the students. Prof. Garg also related a real-life experience to explain how women have been instrumental in planning household finance.

Following this, the discussion began where each of the panelists put forth their thoughts on the sub-themes they chose. The first panelist, Ms. Seema shared her insights on the topic, 'Domestic Help' where she explained how women engaged in the profession have been vital in day-to-day working of every household. However, there are no strict guidelines to provide for minimum wages, social security schemes, maternity leaves, etc. that contribute to their vulnerability significantly.

Following her, Dr. Tanu Kathuria spoke on the topic 'Changing Economic Contribution through Empowered Women'. She elucidated on the challenges faced by women including,

the status of the household they belong, their socio-economic status, family's educational roots that explain their productivity and development interventions while they are striving to get financial independence and empowerment.

Then, Ms. Bhavna Sharma along with Ms. Pranjali collaborated to throw some light on the women in the corporate world with special reference to the ones working on the top tier of hierarchy. The discussion began with Ms. Pranjali's deep insights on the challenges faced by women in the fields of analytics including that of lack of recognition of the efforts put in by women in the corporate set up. Ms. Bhavna Sharma took over the discussion and emphasized on the better performance shown by the organizations with equal participation from both the genders.

The next panelist, Ms. Priyanka Dagar, who is a practicing advocate in Delhi High court spoke about the status of women with respect to ownership of marital property in India. Her discussion weaved around the perennial neglect of the contribution made by women in building families and lack of such recognition evident in the way how property is distributed in unfortunate events, such as divorce.

Two panelist, Ms Kirti Gupta and Ms. Subha Wadhwa both illustrated how lack of communication and initiative on the part of women employees in the corporate sector has been instrumental in their lower positions than the male counterparts explaining their lesser earnings. Both panelists also recognized the challenges faced by women in the workplace, such as unequal pay, gender discrimination, and the lack of opportunities for career advancement. The panelists also agreed that these challenges are still prevalent however, the situation has improved significantly over the years especially after the pandemic.

The next two panelist, Ms. Priyanka Pahuja and Ms. Shivangi Khanna co-owned a successful business venture and explained how financial literacy and entrepreneurial efforts taken by women are instrumental in achieving financial independence. Ms. Pahuja discussed the need to unlock the economic potential of up to 400 million women by 2030 and explained how women entrepreneurs drive transformational gains for individuals, economy and the society. Ms. Khanna on the other hand discussed the lack of investment opportunities available for women startups across the world has been a key feature explaining the lesser startups by women than their male counterparts.

The last panelist for the discussion, Ms. Shruti Mehta spoke about a very important area, 'Education of women by women'. The discussion touched upon the importance of educating girls and encouraging them to take up education seriously as it is the main engine to restructure the status of women in societies.

An interaction session was held after the panelists shared their experiences and observations regarding various themes, in which all the panelists effectively addressed the queries of students. The session was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Vibha Jain, Vice President of the Alumnae Association, JDMC.

The panel discussion was a valuable opportunity for attendees to learn from the experiences of successful women working in different fields after their education in economics.
