

JDMC Alumnae Association organized a special alumnae talk on 29 October, 2025 on the topic "From Classroom To Newsroom: Traversing The Field Of Journalism."

In this session, JDMC's former student, who is currently working as Entertainment and lifestyle Editor at Hindustan Times participated as the chief guest and main speaker.

After welcoming everyone, her introduction was given as a former student of the college. After this, the introduction of the chief speaker was presented.

Ms. Soumya Srivastava began her address by expressing her gratitude toward her teachers and sharing her deep connection with her college.

She emphasised the importance of internships in a student's career. She explained that internships help students gain practical knowledge of their chosen field and understand whether they are genuinely interested in pursuing it further. Internships act as a bridge between theoretical learning and real-world experience, allowing individuals to discover their strengths and areas of interest.

She shared her own internship experience, mentioning that she had completed it from *Hindu College*. Through that opportunity, she gained valuable exposure to the field of media and journalism, which helped her realize her passion for

entertainment and lifestyle reporting. She encouraged all students to take internships seriously and explore various roles early in their academic journey to understand what kind of work excites them the most.

She admitted that although her job does not come with regular holidays, she loves her work so much that it rarely feels tiring. However, she also acknowledged that for some, the continuous hustle could be overwhelming and hectic.

She further discussed the importance of audience engagement in her profession. One of the most crucial aspects of her work, she said, is monitoring "people traffic" — understanding how many people read or view the content they produce. This data helps the team evaluate what type of stories attracts readers and how they can improve their content. She emphasized that audience response is what determines the success of an article in today's digital media world.

The editor also spoke about the perks of her profession, mentioning that her job has given her opportunities to travel to beautiful destinations such as Himachal Pradesh and many other places. She shared that some of these trips were organized by the office itself for editorial purposes, which made the work even more enjoyable and rewarding.

Reflecting on her journey, she revealed that she started her career as an intern and now leads a team of about 15–16 people as the head of the entertainment and lifestyle section. She expressed how rewarding it has been to grow within the organization and continue learning along the way.

She also mentioned that if any student was interested in pursuing a similar career, she would be glad to help them find internship opportunities.

At the end of the session, Ms Soumya invited students to share their questions without any hesitation and many actively participated by asking questions. She Patiently addressed each doubt, providing practical answers which made the session even more enriching and interactive for all attendees.
