**Brief Report:** The event was conducted in three sessions:

**Session 1:** Resource person for this session was Prof A.K Ramakrishnan, Professor, School of International Studies, JNU. The session revolved around Interdisciplinarity, transcending of disciplinary boundaries with various perspectives on understanding theories and thinkers. It also discussed humanising theories by bring in context to connect theories with reality to ignite the interest of the students.

**Session 2:** Resource person for this session was Dr Rajan Kumar, Associate Professor, School of International Studies, JNU. This session focussed on International Relations and its western approach in the classroom space. The session delved into alternate questions of non-western theory of IR and discussed Asian theory as an alternative. It also took into account the nature of classroom and emphasised on contextualising theories of IR in Global South.

**Session 3:** Resource person for this session was Prof Sanjeev Kumar H.M., Professor, Department of Political science, University of Delhi. This session focussed on the subject of Political Theory by drawing attention to its mixed spacio temporal. The session delved into the problem of dialectic, and laid emphasis on trialectical intervention to discover something alternative, something that is indigenous and can be located in the spacio temporal.

The three sessions were followed by intermittent discussions by the faculty members. It was a fruitful, informative and thought provocation session for the faculty members.

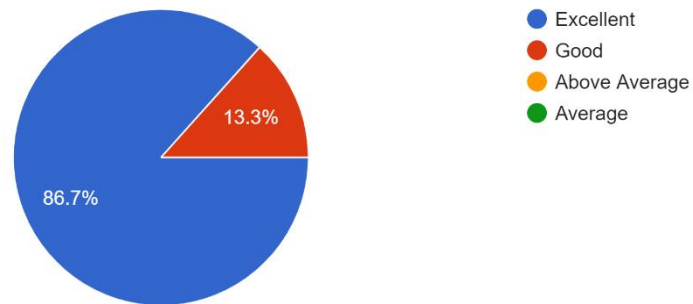

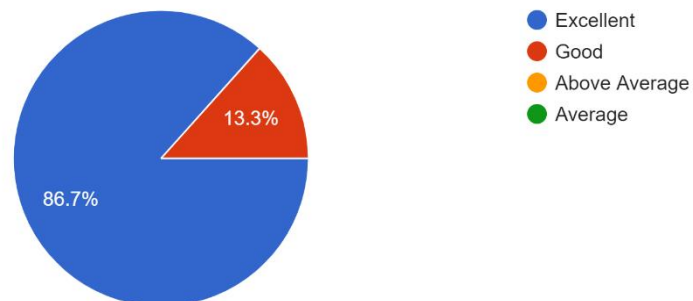
How would you rate the session ?

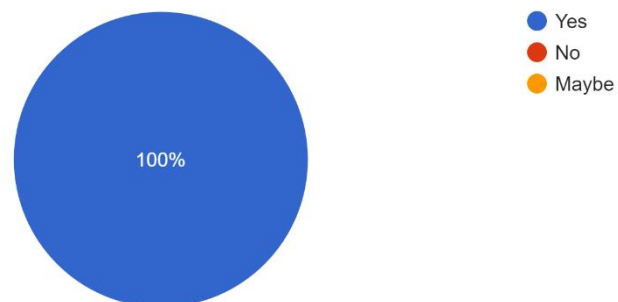
How would you rate the content of the session?

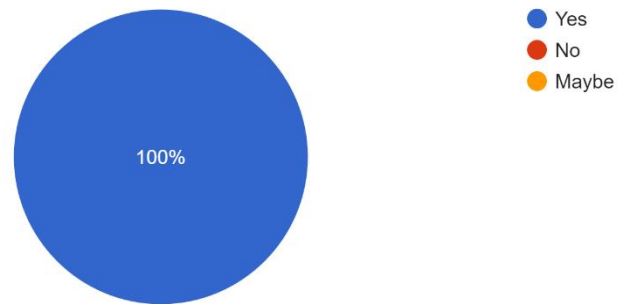
Was the duration of workshop appropriate?

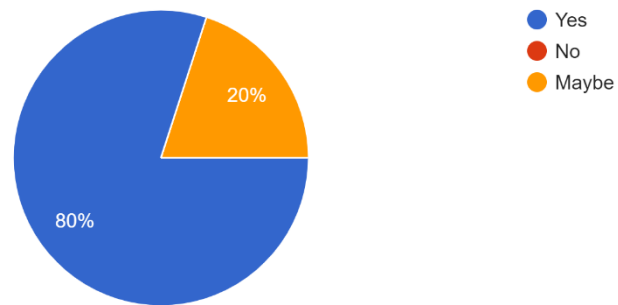
