

The session gave a deeper understanding of the complexities of financial decision-making to the participants and also helped in understanding the evolving financial landscape.


After the presentation, the session was open for questions by the participants who asked their doubts which were answered by the presenters.





Session on Intellectual Property Rights





26 अप्रैल, 2024 को, दिल्ली विश्वविदयालय के जानकी देवी मेमोरियल कॉलेज में गणित, संस्कृत और दर्शनशास्त्र विभागों के द्वारा बौद्धिक संपदा अधिकार विषय पर प्रात: 11 बजे कक्ष संख्या 14 में वक्तव्य का आयोजन किया गया। जिसमें वक्ता के रूप में प्रज्ज्वल कुशवाहा, एसोसिएट आनंद और आनंद को आमंत्रित किया गया। जिसमें विभाग के सदस्यों और छात्राओं के साथ क्ल 50 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। कार्यक्रम का आरंभ मुख्य वक्ता के स्वागत के साथ किया गया। तत्पश्चात अपने वक्तव्य में प्रज्ज्वल क्शवाहा महोदय ने न्याय की बढ़ावा देने, व्यवस्था बनाए रखने और व्यक्तिगत अधिकारों की रक्षा करने में कानून की भूमिका पर प्रकाश डालते हुए, कानून के महत्व को समझाया। उन्होंने बताया कि कैसे कानून विवादों को स्वझाने और समाज में निष्पक्षता स्निश्चित करने के लिए एक रूपरेखा स्थापित करते हैं, व्यक्तियों और सेंगठनों को उनके कार्यों के लिए जवाबदेह बनाने और न्याय स्निश्चित करने के लिए एक तंत्र प्रदान करते हैं। इसके अतिरिक्त, उन्होंने चर्चा की कि कैसे कानून विवादों के संचालन और समाधान के लिए एक पूर्वानुमानित कानूनी ढांचा प्रदान करके आर्थिक और राजनीतिक स्थिरता में योगदान देता है, जिससे आर्थिक विकास और निवेश को बढ़ावा मिलता है। प्रज्ज्वल कुशवाह द्वारा संकाय और छात्रों दोनों के बीच प्रश्नोंतर सत्र ने वक्तव्य को और रुचिकर बना दिया। जिससे चर्चा और समृद्ध हुई। अपने वक्तव्य को जारी रखते हुए, प्रज्ज्वल कुशवाह ने बौद्धिक संपदा कानून (आईपीआर) के बारे में बताया और बताया कि यह कैसे मानव मन की रचनाओं, जैसे आविष्कार, साहित्यिक और कलात्मक कार्यों, डिजाइन, प्रतीकों और वाणिज्य में उपयोग किए जाने वाले नामों की रक्षा करता है। इसमें पेटेंट, कॉपीराइट, ट्रेडमार्क, व्यापार रहस्य और संबंधित अधिकार शामिल हैं। उन्होंने जॉन डेकोर्डर, मार्वेवा इनजस्टिस, ट्रेडवर्क, कॉपीराइट कानून, कॉपीराइट अधिनियम 1957 (भारत) और ट्रेडमार्क अधिनियम 1999 (भारत) पर भी चर्चा की। उन्होंने कानून और संवैधानिक अधिकारों के नैतिकता पहलुओं को समझने, सामाजिक स्धार के साधन के रूप में कानून के बारे में बात की। उन्होंने बताया कैसे कानून में करियर कॉर्पोरेट कानून, बौद्धिक संपदा कानून, आपराधिक कानून, पारिवारिक कानून, कर कानून और वैंकल्पिक कानूनी करियर सहित विभिन्न धाराओं और विशेषज्ञता प्रदान करता है। कार्यक्रम का समापन वक्ता प्रज्ज्वल क्शवाह के प्रयासों की सराहना एवं धन्यवाद ज्ञापन के साथ किया गया।
