

Ms. Bhawna took the session forward and told the meaning of Academic Plagiarism and how it is spreading in today's world. She informed the audience that Academic plagiarism occurs when a writer repeatedly uses more than four words from a printed source without the use of quotation marks and a precise reference to the original source in a work presented as the author's own research. Today, Plagiarism has become a menace. Every journal editor or conference organizers has to deal with this problem. Simply Copying or rephrasing of text without giving due credit to the original author has become more common.

Ms. Bhawna discussed the various kinds of Plagiarism like Hybrid Plagiarism, Mashup Plagiarism, Aggregator plagiarism and many more. The speaker gave a briefing about the Plagiarism Disciplinary Authority (PDA) of the HEI and what are regulations and penalties that come under it. They informed the students about the Penalties for students, Staff, faculty and researchers of HEI. We got to know about the parameters and the levels of similarities on the basis of which plagiarism is detected. They further spoke about the various similarly checks for exclusion from Plagiarism. The speaker also gave a detailed insight about Ouriginal, the Plagiarism detection website and also gave a demo on how the use it. She concluded by telling the students about the harmful effects of plagiarism. It was really a very informative and insightful session. The speaker addressed the audience's query sincerely. 


