OBSERVATIONS: Based on the provided responses, it is noted that approximately 92-95% of students either strongly agreed or agreed that this course significantly contributed to their comprehension of child development as a field, including the concept of prenatal development. Additionally, more than 90% of students expressed agreement that the course equipped them with a foundational understanding of data collection techniques, elucidating the scope and utility of the subject. More than 85% of students grasped the multidisciplinary nature of the course. Furthermore, it was observed that 78% of students maintained attendance levels of 50% and above (17.9% students maintained attendance level of 67% and above).

ACTION PLAN REPORT:

In response to a small number of responses, identified topics will be addressed in remedial classes utilizing innovative teaching and learning methods such as quizzes and discussions.

Efforts will be directed towards making classes more captivating and engaging, incorporating audio-visual aids and group discussions, to boost overall class attendance.



Based on the provided responses, it is evident that approximately 94-96% of students expressed strong agreement or agreement that the course significantly contributed to their understanding of the status of women and children in India. They also gained knowledge about various programs and services designed for the welfare of women and children in the country. The majority of students acknowledged an increased awareness of the significance of maternal health and education. The course played a crucial role in equipping students with knowledge and skills necessary to work effectively with women and children.

Around 83-86% of the students reported that the course helped them improve their research-related skills and fostered a scientific temperament.

Additionally, it was noted that 40% of students maintained attendance levels of 67% and above.

For a few responses received - remedial classes will address identified topics. Efforts will be made to enhance class engagement to improve overall attendance rates.



A significant portion of the student body indicated that the course acquainted them with Constitutional provisions for women, facilitated exploration and discussion of government initiatives in gender justice over the past 5 years, and provided opportunities to apply theoretical knowledge in practical scenarios.

Additionally, it was noted that 41.2% of students maintained attendance levels of 67% and above.

Furthermore, the course sensitized them to various challenges faced by children, fostering a better comprehension of gender sensitization, gender stereotypes, and patriarchy within the Indian context. A significant number of students reported the development of critical thinking skills in the realm of gender roles and stereotypes, with the course providing valuable opportunities for fieldwork.

Additionally, it was observed that 42.9% of the students maintained attendance levels of 67% and above.

For the moderate responses received, topics will be addressed in remedial classes using various innovative methods. To improve class attendance, efforts will be made to increase student interest and engagement in the classes.



ACTION TO BE TAKEN REPORT:


