Talk on Triple Talaq

On 9th September, 2017 the Association organised a talk on Triple Talaq by Khadija Faruqi. She talked about Islam as a religion based on justice and peace and Quran as its law book. According to Islam marriage is a contract and the procedure to annul it is laid down in Quran. Faruqi emphasised that triple talaq is unconstitutional and that personal law can be challenged in supreme court if it violates fundamental rights.
