Jobs is portrayed by Michael Fassbender, with Kate Winslet, Seth Rogen, Katherine Waterston, Michael Stuhlbarg and Jeff Daniels in supporting roles. All the students and the faculty members found the movie very informative and inspiring.

### **AN INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO MOTHER DAIRY PLANT, PATPARGANJ**

On 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, An industrial visit to Mother Dairy Plant, Patparganj was organised by commerce association. 107 students from 1st year of the commerce department and 4 faculty members went for an Industrial visit to Mother Dairy Plant. The buses were boarded at 8:15 with a proper headcount. Everyone was provided with light refreshments. The students reached the plant at 9:00am. After reaching the plant of mother dairy, the students had a warming session with the Co-ordinator. He explained the students about several milk products like curd, ice cream, ghee, etc. & 8 varieties of milk. The plant produces milk that goes into Token counters at Mother Dairy Milk-shops. The daily average of production is 35 lakhs liters. The students also got to know the inner workings of the plant after they were shown the machinery involved in the whole process from Clarification to Pasteurization to Distribution. The processes used to check for adulteration, and used 25 parameters to check for contamination. As the trip drew close to the end, they treated the students with milk and ice-cream. The

students went with curious minds, but came back with enlightened ones. The bus reached back college at 1.10 pm.
