
Brief Report:

Brief Report

The seminar began with an overview of the labour force participation rate (LFPR) in India and its link with GDP. It highlighted the declining LFPR across countries and explored the connection between education and employment. Interestingly, in rural areas, women's chances of employment decrease with higher education, while in urban areas, higher education boosts employment opportunities.

The evolution of LFPR from the 1980s to 2018 was discussed, showing a sharp decline in female employment. Rural and urban trends were compared, noting that women have historically been concentrated in agriculture, whereas sectors like mining and quarrying remain male-dominated. The seminar also presented key insights from the Gender Parity Index, emphasizing persistent inequalities.










Factors influencing women's employment included socio-cultural norms, household responsibilities, safety, mobility, and access to skills. The discussion on occupational segregation showed women are often concentrated in informal, low-paid jobs, while men dominate formal and high-paying sectors.

The seminar ended with an interactive question-and-answer session, where participants discussed challenges and potential solutions to improve female labour force participation and reduce occupational segregation in India.

Brief Report

The Department of Economics, Janki Devi Memorial College, organised a workshop on Data Collection and Report Writing on 14th November 2025. The session was led by Dr. Rachna Mathur, Assistant Professor, Gargi College, University of Delhi. Dr. Mathur explained the basics of data collection, types of data, sample size, and the role of pilot surveys. She walked students through the research process - from defining objectives to designing questionnaires, fieldwork, data entry, and analysis. She also shared her own field experiences and stressed the importance of punctuality, integrity, and realistic data. The workshop covered literature review, how to write research papers, structuring references, and using tools like QuillBot and Google Scholar. Students found the session engaging and insightful, especially her reminder that “research is a journey close to your heart.”


