





1. The Department has scheduled a 1-Day National Seminar & Inter-college Competition on 'Innovating Pathways for a Sustainable Future: Bridging Environment, Entrepreneurship and Sustainability' on March 21, 2025. The Department of Environmental Studies and AVANI will organise the seminar in collaboration with National EduTrust of India. Prof. Radhey Shyam Sharma from the Department of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi and a representative from National EduTrust of India will be the resource persons for the event.
2. The department has successfully completed a project on plant identification and the generation of QR codes for the Biodiversity Trail in the college campus. Each plant species was scientifically identified, documented, and tagged with a unique QR code that, when scanned, provides detailed information about its common name, scientific name, ecological significance, and other relevant facts. This initiative promotes environmental awareness, self-learning, and appreciation of campus biodiversity among students and visitors, reflecting the department's commitment to conservation education and the innovative use of technology in environmental sciences.
3. The Department organised 8 field trips to Yamuna Biodiversity Park and Aravalli Biodiversity Park on February 15, 2025, February 17-19, 2025, February 24-25, 2025, and March 4-5, 2025, for the fourth semester BA (Prog.), BA Philosophy (Hons.), BA Hindi (Hons.), BA Sanskrit (Hons.), BA Economics (Hons.), BA Sociology (Hons.), and BSc Mathematics (Hons.) students. As a part of the AEC Environmental Sciences curriculum, the department undertakes regular field visits to enhance the student's practical understanding of the subject and expose them to biodiversity in Delhi.
4. The Department coordinated the Aerobiology Walk Tour in college on January 17, 2025, as a part of the Diploma in Pediatric Allergy & Asthma (DPAA) course offered by Sir Ganga Ram Hospital. Aerobiology Walks are organised as a part of an MoU with Dr Neeraj Gupta, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital.
5. The Department organised 8 field trips to Aravalli Biodiversity Park between November 4-12, 2025, for the fourth semester BA English (Hons.), BA Political Science (Hons.), BA History (Hons.), BCom (Hons.), and BCom (Prog.) students. As a part of the AEC Environmental Sciences curriculum, the department undertakes regular field visits to enhance the student's practical understanding of the subject and expose them to biodiversity in Delhi.

6. The Department organised an Environment Quiz Competition as a part of Swachhta Pakhwada 2024 in collaboration with AVANI-The Environment Club on September 23, 2024.
7. The Department conducted a Workshop on pedagogy on 5th September 2024 in the committee room of the college. Dr Nawin Tiwary from Indraprastha College, University of Delhi, was invited as the guest speaker and successfully conducted the session.
8. The Department organised its annual Academic audit by inviting Prof. A.P. Dimri, Director, Indian Institute of Geomagnetism, Mumbai, on 4th July 2024.
9. The Department coordinated the Energy/Environmental/Green Audit of the college conducted by external auditor Dr Uday Pratap from the EHS Alliance Services on May 24, 2024.
