

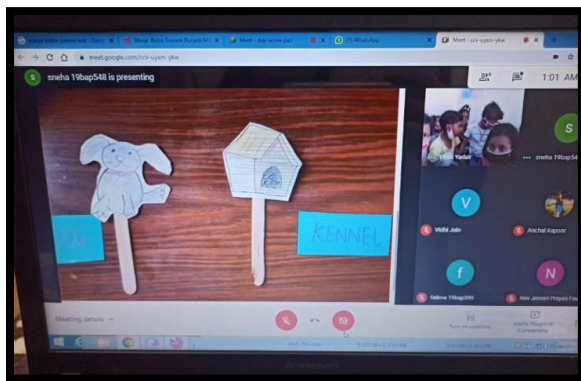

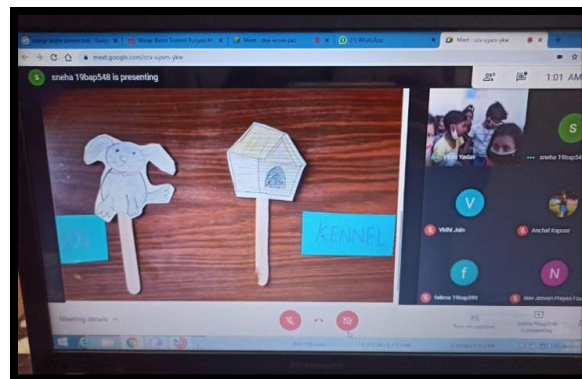

1. INTERNSHIP IN PLAY SCHOOLS - FEBRUARY, 2021 – MARCH, 2021

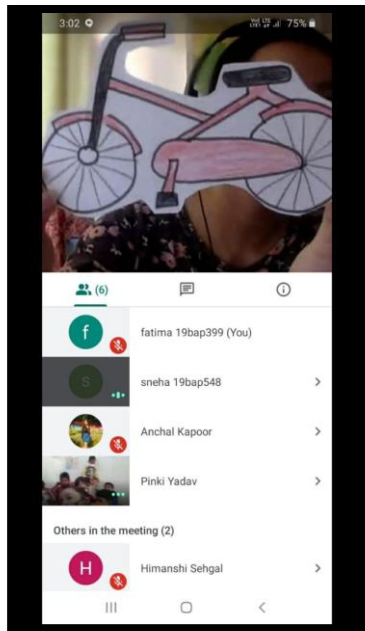

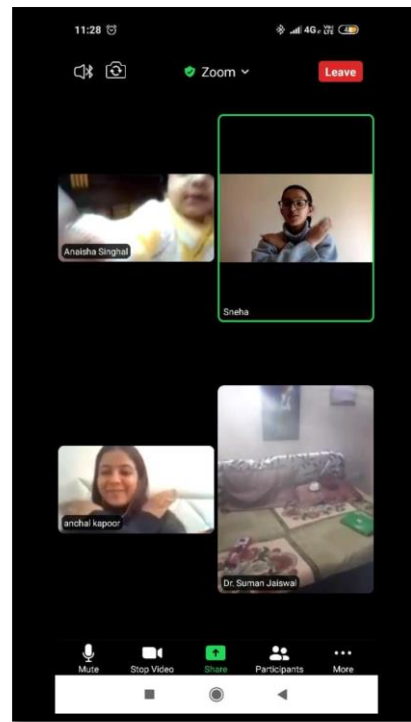

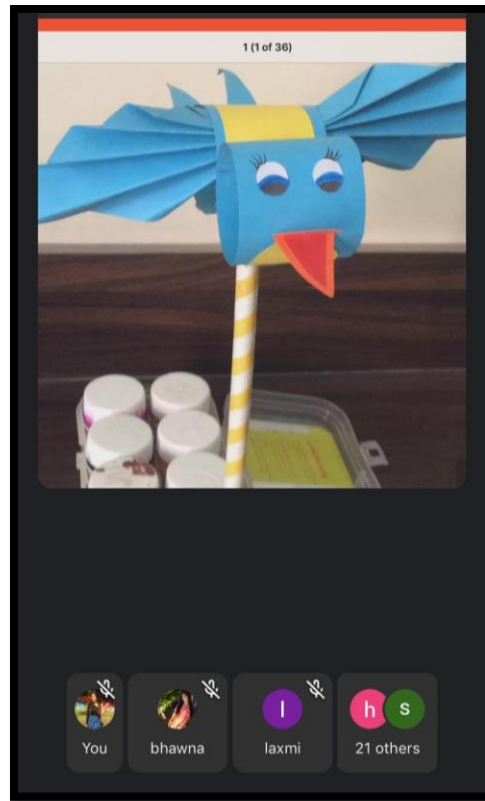
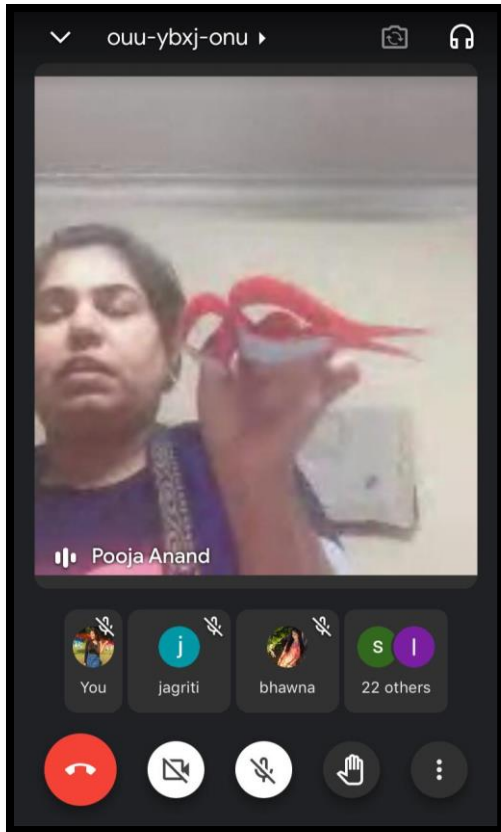
3. MASK AND PUPPET WORKSHOP – JANUARY 28TH, 2021

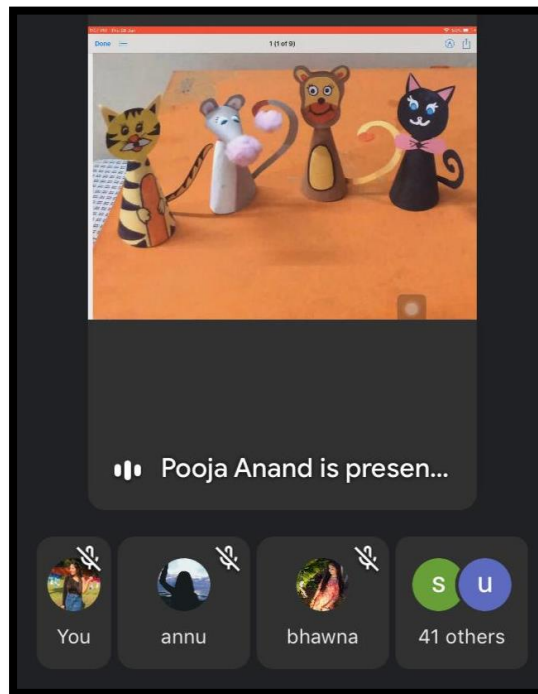



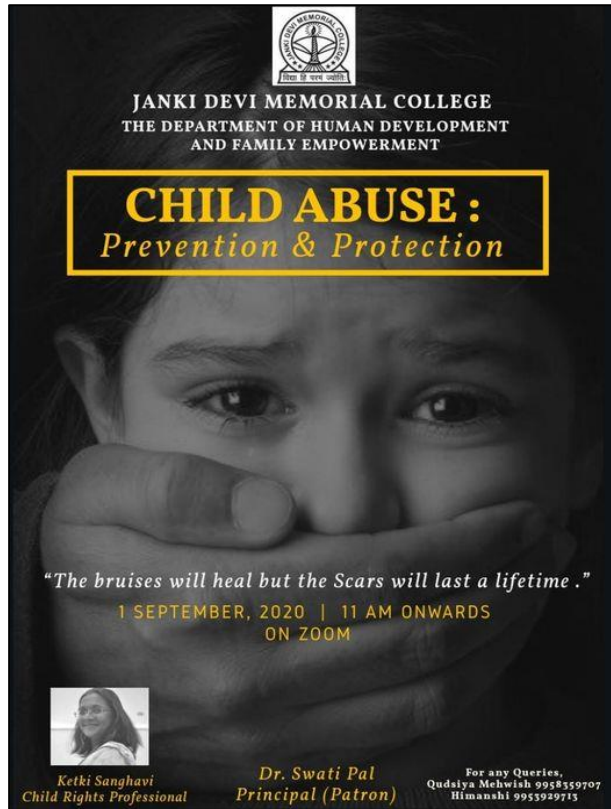
