

Three Day Book Exhibition on Yoga Day 21st -23rd June 2023



ANNUAL LIBRARY FESTIVAL 2023 – A REPORT

Despite all the developmental changes faced by libraries, people have continued to collect books and documents to shape and preserve our collective body of knowledge. Therefore, to inculcate the habit of reading and learning in our students, JDMC library started the library festival and I feel proud to state that ours is the only college which organizes a Lib-Fest every year. JDMC Library organized week-long activities as part of its Annual Library Festival which began on October 9 Several Intercollege activities for students were organized s like photography competition on "My Library," poetry writing, poster making, and a Braille reading competition for our students with special needs was also organized. All the events witnessed overwhelming response from the participants across the colleges. We have also felicitated two final year students for the maximum use of the library. Such felicitations encourage other students to use the library.

On 18th October, the Library hosted a Panel Discussion on the topic 'Libraries are still Relevant in Digital Era' celebrate the annual College Library Festival.

Dr Sanjay Garg, Deputy Director, National Archives, chaired the session. Other Panellists included Prof Nandini Sahu, Poet and Writer, IGNOU, Mr Kumar Sanjay, Director Library, Niti Ayog and Dr Aakash Singh, Senior Assistant Librarian, National Law University New Delhi. The event commenced with the Kulgeet along with lighting of the lamp. The Principal Prof Swati Pal welcome the guests and the Librarian Dr Nivedita Sharma, presented the library report and spoke on the importance of the theme of the Panel Discussion. Dr Sanjay Garg in his opening remarks, spoke of the need to inculcate reading habits and suggested that the libraries of today needed to expand their roles beyond borrowing books. Prof. Nandini Sahu shared her experiences and love for the libraries and books, how she used to smell the books and read in her childhood. The amount of time that she has spent in libraries and shaped her life. She also talked about book publishing and the Publishing Course run by IGNOU. Mr Kumar Sanjay spoke about the importance and authenticity of information that we get from libraries. He said that from Google we can get 100 answers but the one which is most relevant and required can be sought from the library. He also mentioned five laws of library science. He stressed on the idea that reading is important to understand a person and their character. Dr Akash Singh talked about the presence of library since ancient times, he mentioned Takshashila and Nalanda Libraries. He also spoke about the importance of search engines like CORE, JURN an open access journal.

Two Books were also launch on this occasion. 1. In Search of Delhi translated by Dr Jitender Gill and Dr Namita Sethi and 2. Rediscovering Shahjahanabad Edited by Dr Jitender Gill and Co-Editor Dr Khurshid Alam.

The event ended with a vote of thanks and the performance of the national anthem. It was enthusiastically attended and appreciated with the promise of further engagement with the speakers in individual sessions in the coming days.
