




#### **Brief Report**


Pranali is a graduate of NLU, Nagpur and LLM from NLU, Delhi.

The students also discussed how gender sensitisation needs to focus on men and women. Unless we bring about a change in the mindset of people at large the safety of women and their rights will be a challenge.




