

Criteria for the selection of candidates for Prize-- Proficiency in English Prize and Aruna Chakravarti Prize for Creative Writing

Prize 9 - the is given to the student getting highest marks in English Discipline BA Prg. in the preceding semesters, as these students actually study English Literature over a course of three years and get an immersive experience of English.

Prize 10 -: The English Department Association conducts a creative writing competition for assessing the Aruna Chakravarti Creative Writing Competition award. The competition is open for students of all years and courses. Topics are agiven on the spot and the students are given an hour's time to write. The first prize winner receives the award.

We invite nominations for the above-mentioned prizes from II and III Year students only.



2. Rs 2500 Shri Sultan Chand Memorial Scholarship for the best student of B.Com(Hons.) I Year


