


How much was your attendance in this program?






Please compare yourself before and after graduation. Please pause for a moment and reflect upon: What have been the contributions of your three years of graduation in this program and in this college?




There has been Improvement in my communication skills




I am better equipped to engage in more and confident social interactions


I rate myself as a better and an aware citizen






I understand the importance of ethics and values




I understand the issues of environment and sustainable development

Observations:-

From the responses it is observed that 80.5% had more than 67% of attendance, 16.7% had 50-67% attendance and 6.8% had less than 50% attendance.

At the end of the programme, 49.2% students agreed that the programme engaged their critical

thinking, 49.2 % agreed that the programme improved their communication skills, 51.7% agreed that their confidence and soft skills improved, 59.3% students agreed that they were more engaged citizen, 55.9% agreed that the programme developed their ethics and values, 52.5% agreed that programme engaged them in issues of environment and sustainable development, and 46.6% were confident that they were directed to be self-sufficient and lifelong learners. The overwhelming feedback has been positive.

Actions to be taken:-

- 1. To help students gain competence in English and Hindi communication the college will encourage them to use the language lab.
- 2. Arrange more remedial classes for students who need additional academic support in all courses.
- 3. To give more tutorials to Improve writing skills.

- 4. To help with know their subjects more effectively, they will be encouraged to practice through class presentations, group discussions, field trips, internships (where applicable) and debates.
- 5. More interactive classroom by using ICT through the Smart Classroom.
