

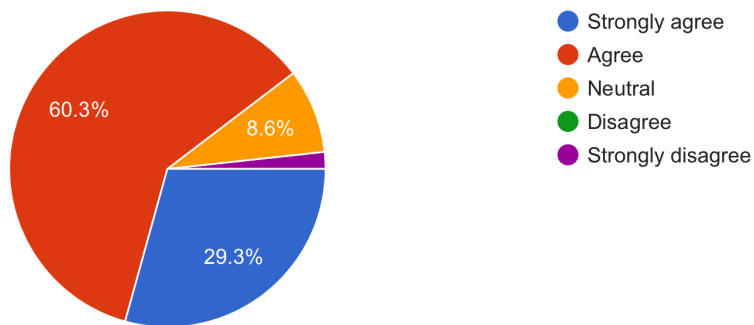

Pie Charts based on the students response:

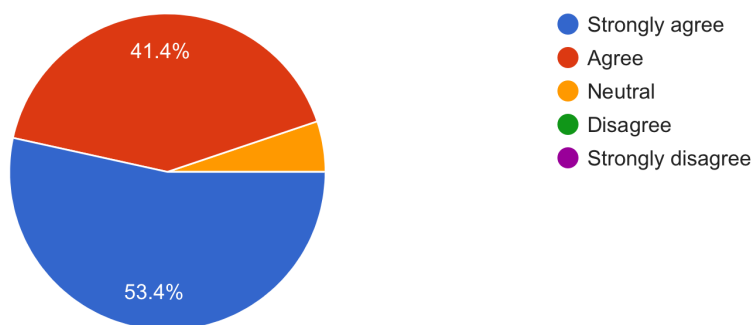
This program has helped me to develop the questioning attitude, critical thinking and analytical reasoning

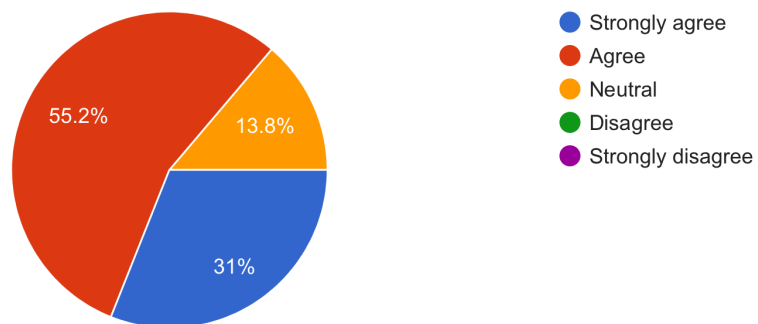
This program has made me aware about the importance of rights as well as duties and various civic virtues associated with the citizenship

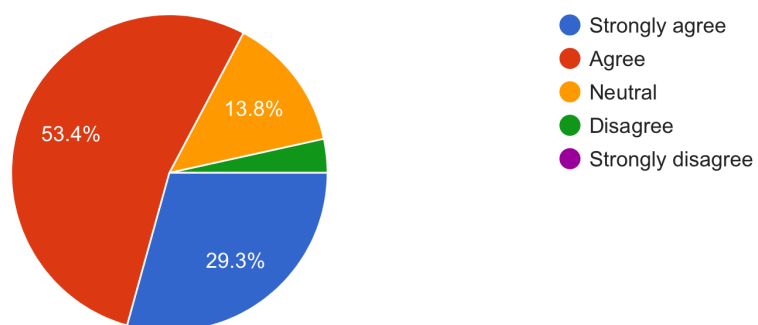
This program had helped me to understand my potential as well as means to achieve it to the fullest

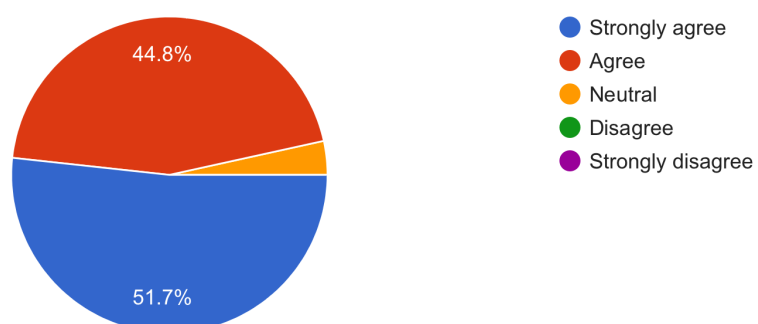
During the course of this program, I have become a positive, confident and a responsible person

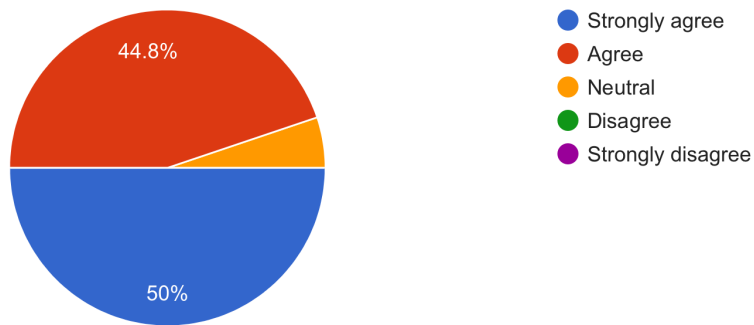
This program has enhanced my understanding about the Constitution of India and various values enshrined in it

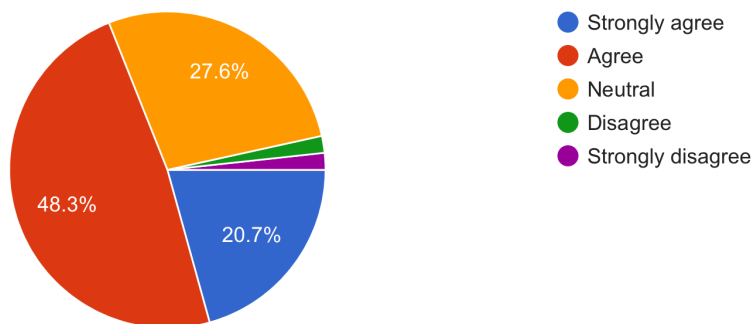
This program has made me aware about the functioning of the Indian democracy and its strengths and weaknesses

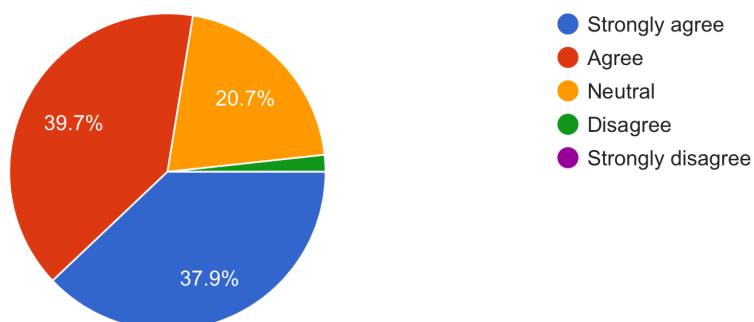

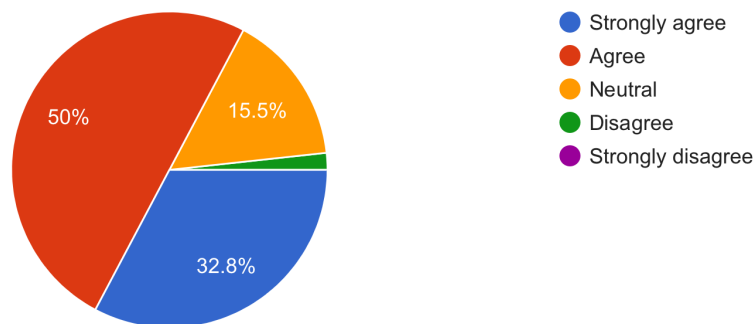
This program has increased my interest in the politics of India

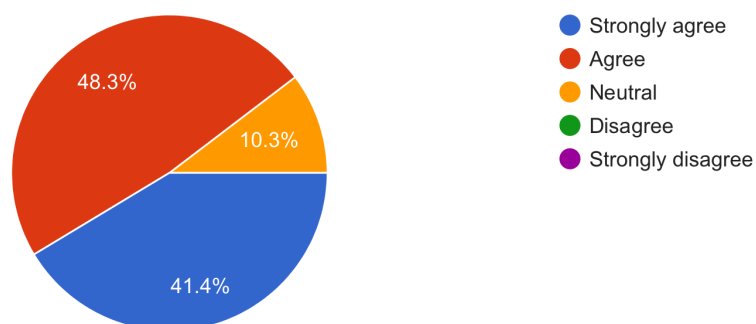
This program has enabled me to understand the ideas of various Western and Indian philosophers and their relevance in contemporary times

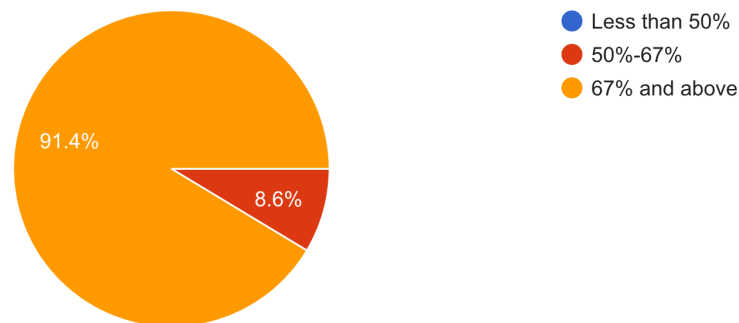

Observations:

General Course outcomes:

From the responses, it is observed that, 90% of the students agreed that the BA(Hons.) Political Science program has helped them to develop the questioning attitude, critical thinking and analytical reasoning, 95% agreed that the program has made them aware about the importance of rights as well as duties and various civic virtues associated with the citizenship, 86% agreed that the program helped them to understand their potential as well as means to achieve it to the fullest, 81% agreed that the program has equipped them with necessary life skills required to handle the challenges in future, 84% agreed that during the course of this program, they have become a positive, confident and a responsible person.

Program Specific Outcomes:

From the responses, it is observed that, 96% of the students agreed that the program has enhanced their understanding about the Constitution of India and various values enshrined in it, 95% of the students agreed that the program has made them aware about the functioning of the Indian democracy and its strengths and weaknesses, 76% of the students agreed that the program has enhanced their trust in various branches of the government including the Parliament and the Judiciary, 78% of the students agreed that the program has increased their interest in the politics of India, 83% of the students agreed that the program has enabled them to understand the ideas of various Western and Indian philosophers and their relevance in contemporary times, 90% of the students agreed that the program has made them aware about various global challenges like climate change and global warming, terrorism, global pandemics, arms race, nuclear proliferation etc.

91% of the students had more than 67% attendance in this program and only 9% of the students had less than 67% attendance.

Overall the feedback from the students has been positive and encouraging. Negative responses to all the questions was in the range of 5-25% only.

Action to be Taken:

Based on the response and feedback from the students, the Department will take following initiatives: Field visits, excursion activities etc. will be organised in future to enable students to link what they have studied with the practical reality.

Considering the importance of training and guidance in research field, special sessions regarding how to conduct the research, how to write research proposal etc. will be held. Students will be given a prior information about the notable think tanks and research institutions and all the possible help will be rendered to enable them to get internships at such institutions.

For Hindi medium students, translation of academic articles and chapters from the books will be provided well in advance.

For slow and advance learners, regular remedial classes and mentoring support will be provided.

Considering the importance of digital education in enhancing the quality, equity and accessibility of education, interactive classrooms through the use of the of ICT including the smart boards will be promoted.
