

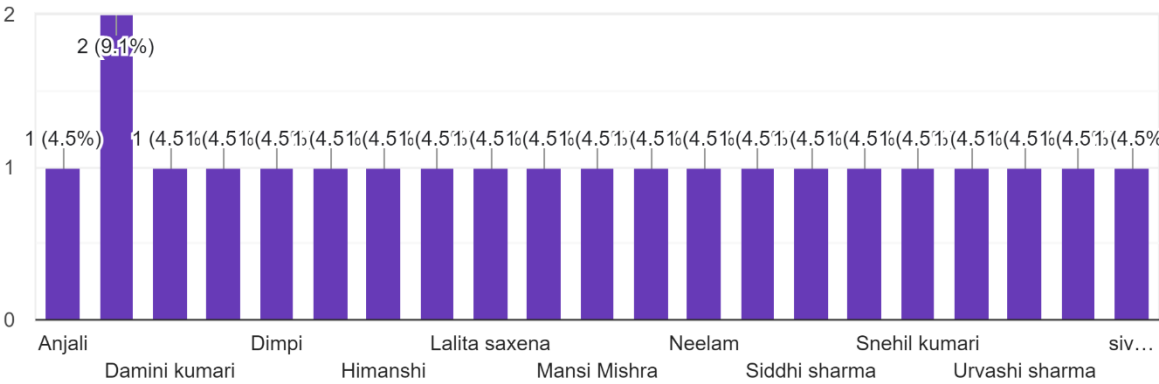

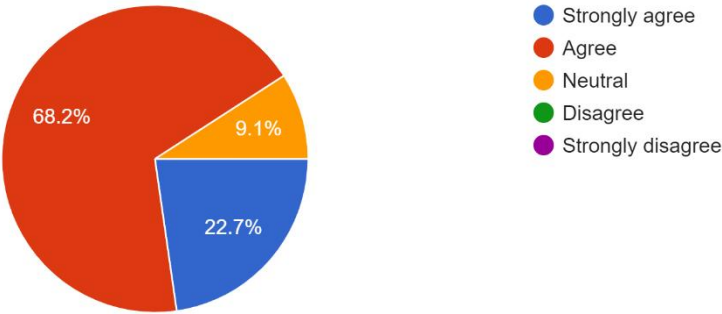

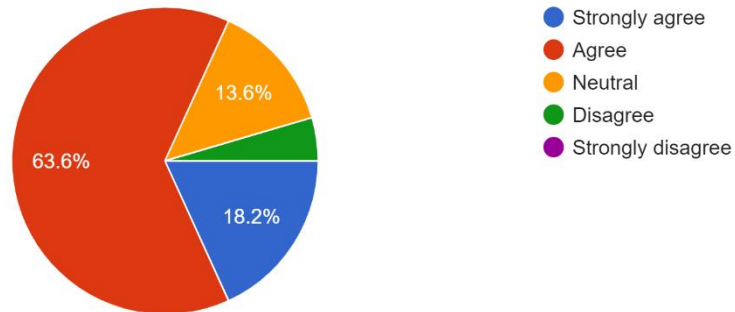
I am better equipped to Engage in Critical Thinking.

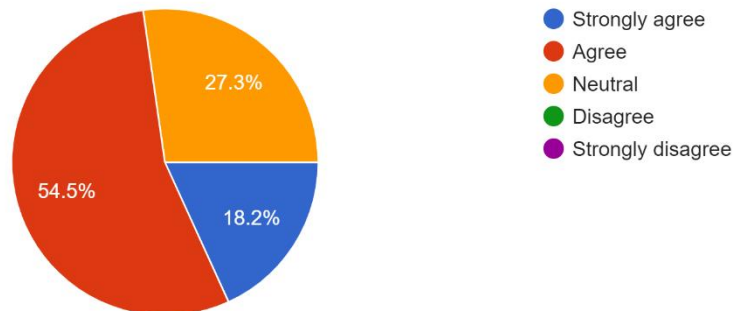
There has been an improvement in my communication skills.

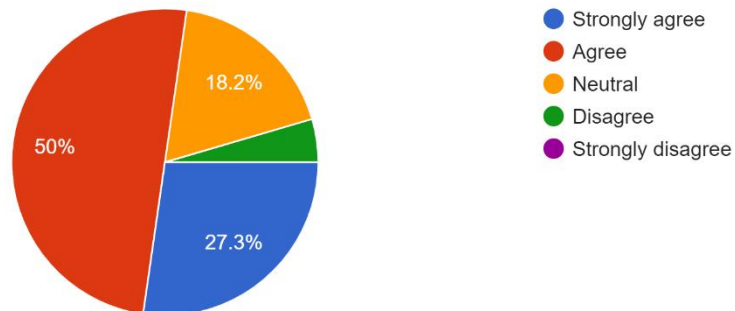
I am better equipped to engage in more confident social interactions.

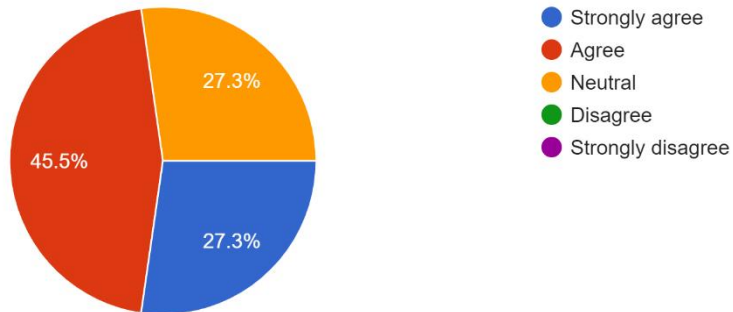
I rate myself as a better and an aware citizen.

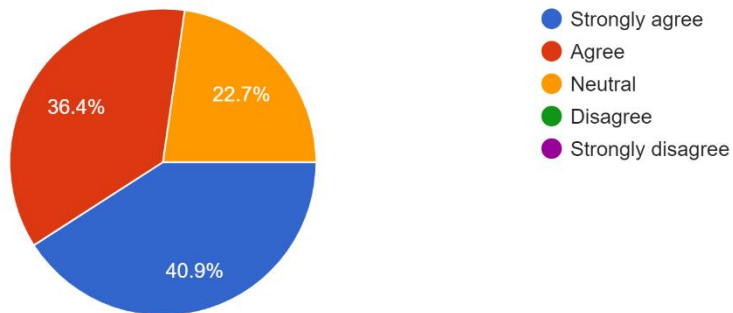
I understand the importance of ethics and values.

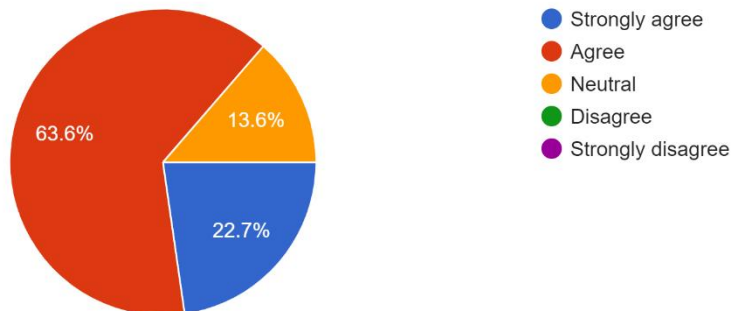
I understand the issues of the environment and sustainable development.

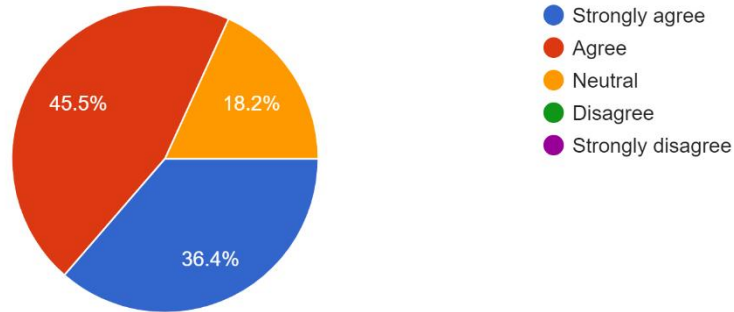

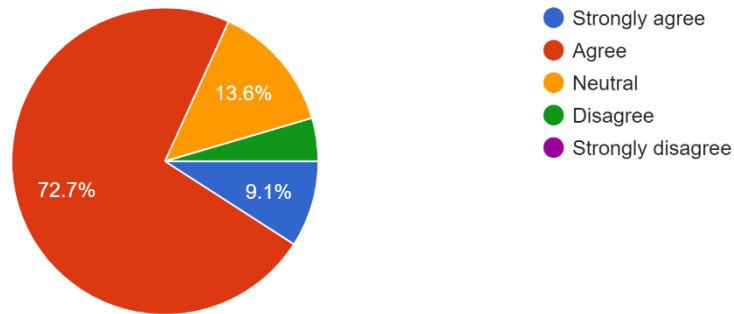

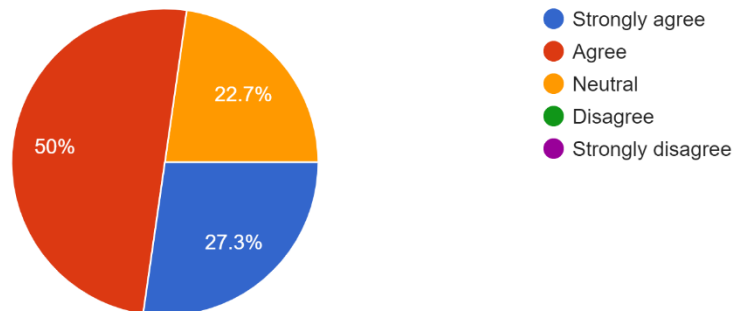
I have learned the Grammatical rules of the Sanskrit language necessary to understand Sanskrit Texts properly.

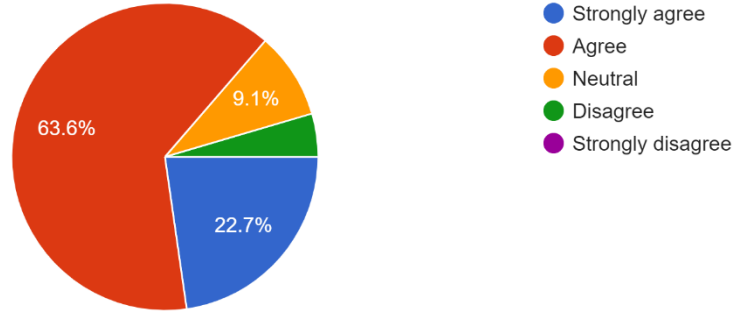
This program gave an introduction to the real world of Sanskrit. The issues and problems facing the country and the world can be solved through Sanskrit texts.

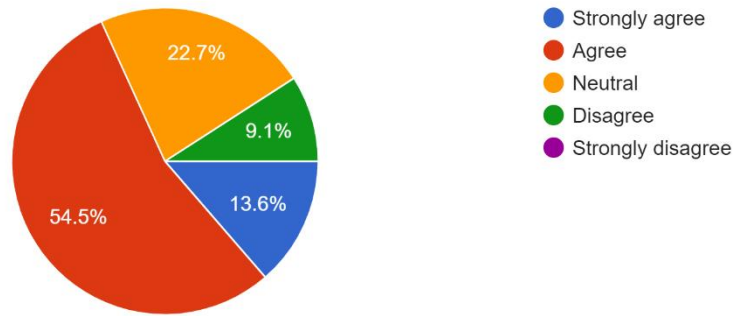
This program provided me the ability to understand Sanskrit shastras, i.e., Vedas, Upanisad, Ramayan, Mahabharat, etc.

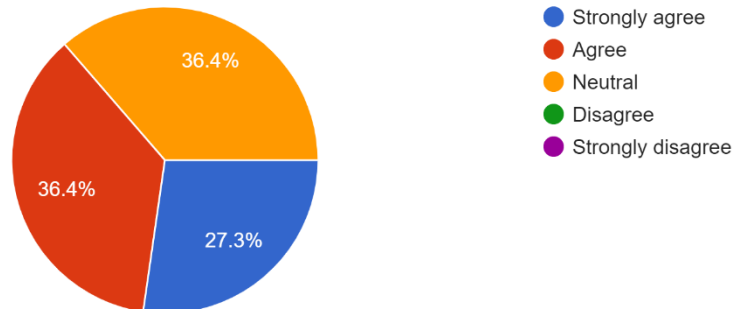

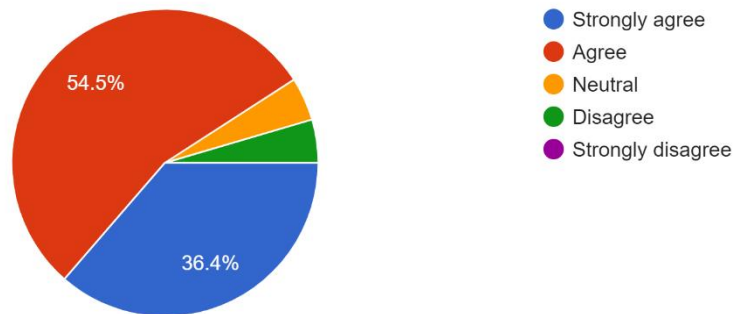
This program helped me learn to use the philosophy, psychology, willpower, inner strength, consciousness, Yoga, etc., while dealing with the world in even-odd circumstances.

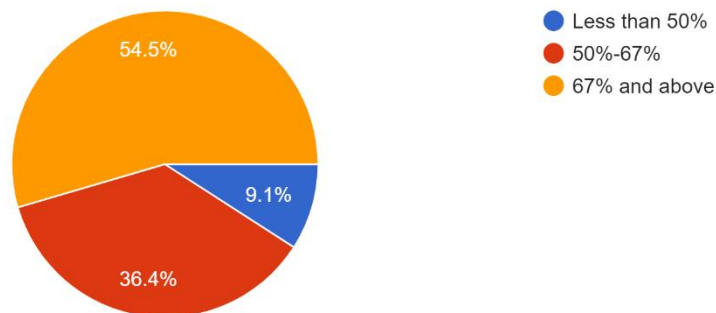
This program trained me in the art of balanced living.

Observations

A total of 22 responses have been received, More than 68% of students have bettered themselves in critical thinking. There is a good improvement in communications skills and confidence in interactions but there is a requirement of more work to be done to improve the implementation of actions which display the usage of ethics, values, environment and sustainable development, philosophy, psychology, yoga at individual level among students. On the other hand, they feel that this program has helped them in getting a good knowledge of Sanskrit language, they feel confident in Sanskrit grammar knowledge. They have had a good exposure of Sanskrit literature, reading and writing practices. Almost 90% of students had good attendance.

Action to be taken

As it is observed that students are lacking the practical exposure of usage of acquired knowledge. More interaction based activities in classes can be considered while teaching. There can be several events like webinars/seminars, workshops which discusses the importance of ethics, environment sustainability. Students can be motivated to attend such events at other institutes as well. They can be sent to participate in competitions, workshops which involves testing of their

communications, reading and writing skills in the Sanskrit language. Usage of ICT tools can be increased in the lecture deliveries to increase the impact of teaching.
