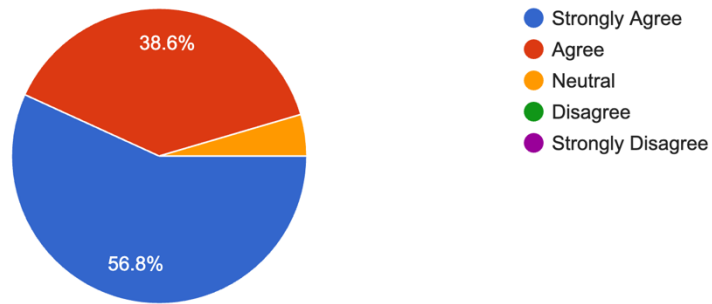


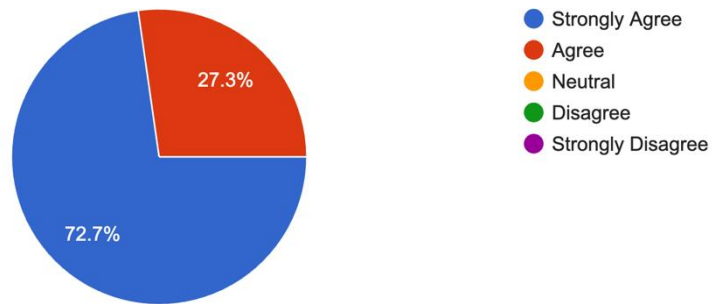

B.A.(Hons) Sociology Programme has exposed graduates to the multiple theoretical perspectives in Sociology

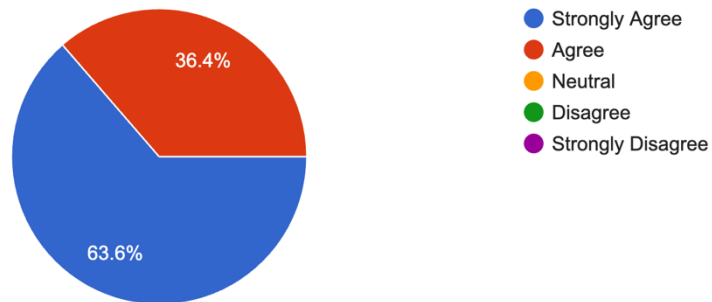

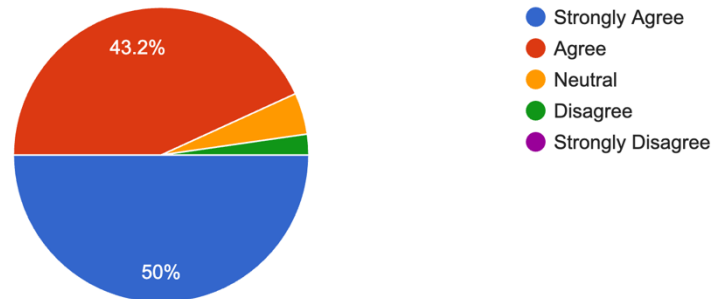


The Programme has enabled the graduate to recognize the universal significance of social institutions in society

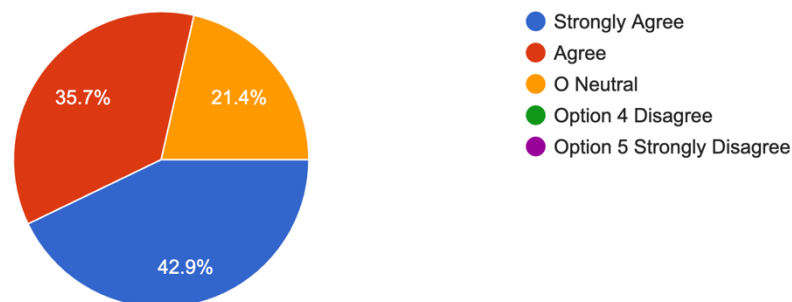
The DSE and GE Courses have highlighted the significance of the inter-disciplinary nature of the courses in Sociology

OBSERVATIONS

Most students felt that they were exposed to multiple theoretical perspectives as a part of studying the programme, B.A. (H) Sociology. The entire class pointed out through the programme they learnt that the knowledge is socially constructed and social institutions are universally significant. Above 80% of students indicated that the GE and DSE courses reveal interdisciplinary nature of the discipline of Sociology. More than half the class stated that the Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) have trained them with skills in the pursuit of Academics and Ethnographic Filmmaking.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

In future students will be further engaged with extra sociological texts and interdisciplinarity. Students will be given greater exposure to practice-based/ field-oriented pedagogy that will enhance their skills in the pursuit of academics and ethnographic filmmaking. Remedial classes will also be taken for the weak students and assessments at regular intervals. Advanced learners will be given more opportunities to engage in sociological forums and participate in internships.
