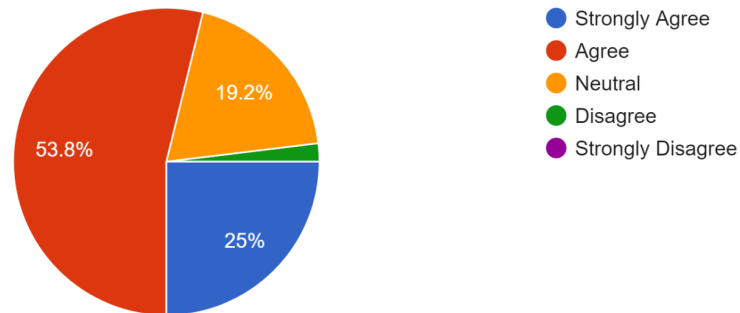

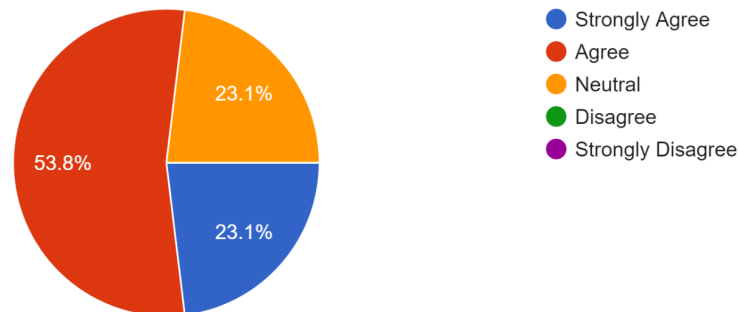
I am better equipped to Engage in Critical Thinking.

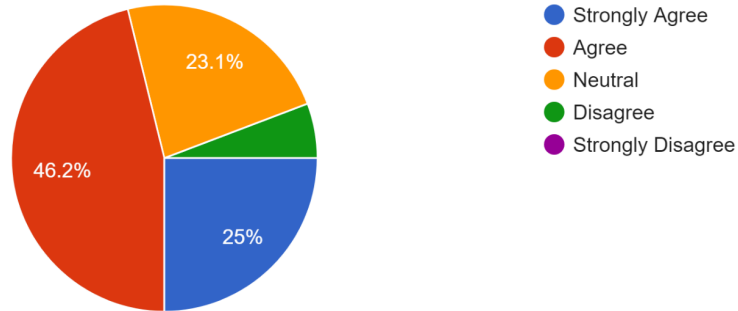
There has been Improvement in my communication skills.

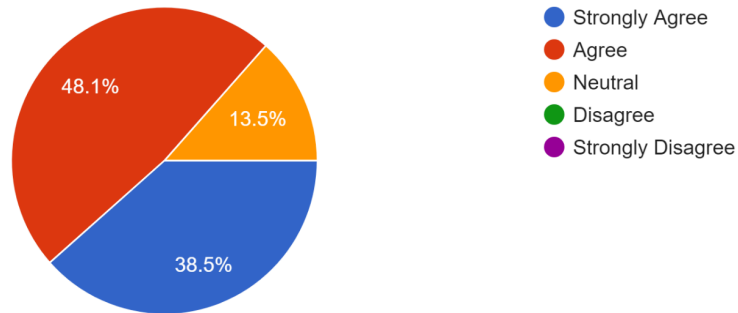

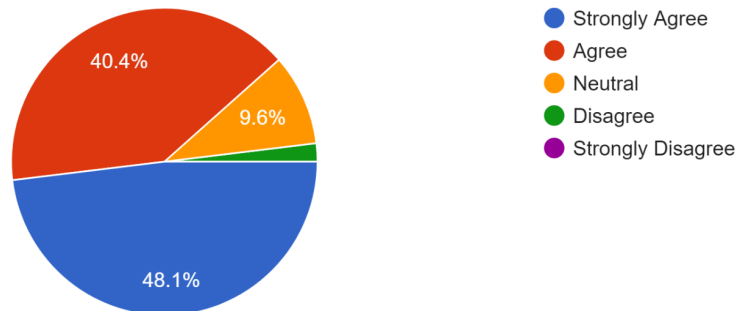

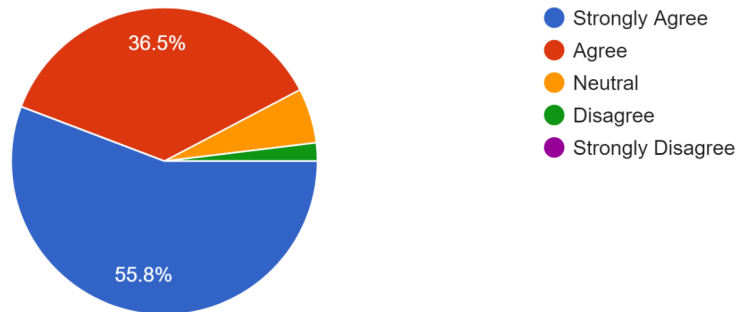
I Understand the importance of ethics and values.

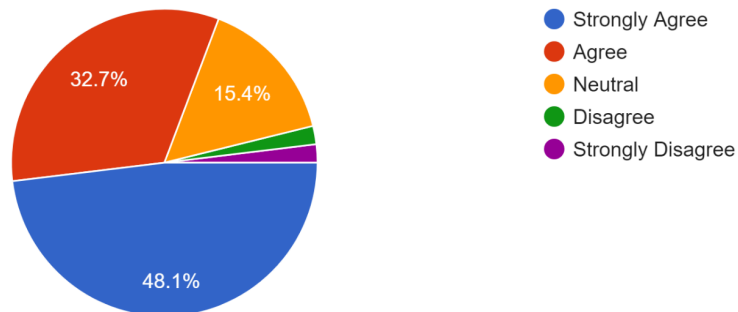

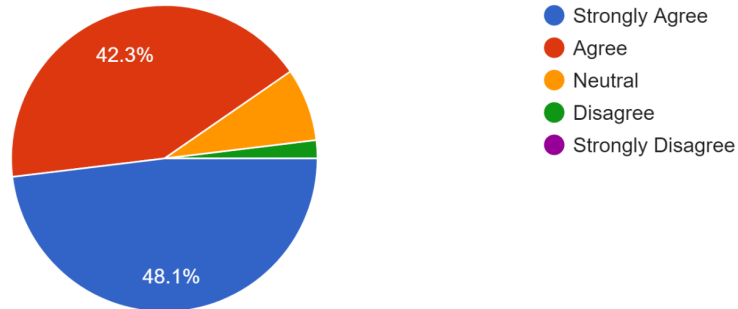

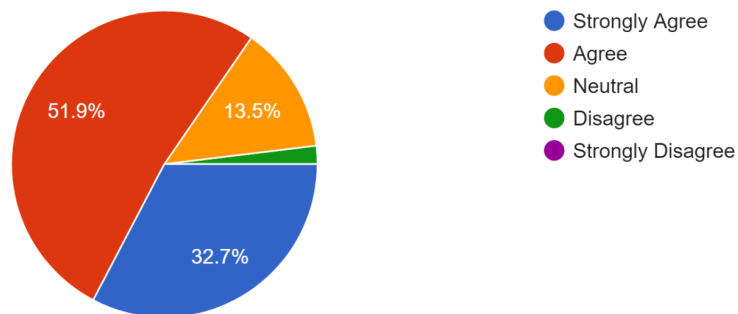
This program helped me to get an understanding of basic themes, concepts, chronology, and the scope of Indian and World History

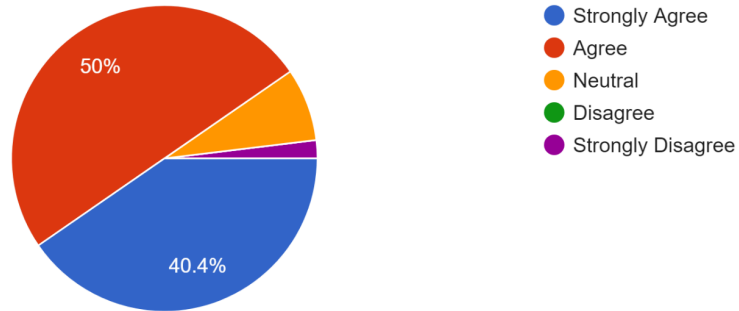
This program helped me to learn the techniques of understanding sources necessary for a proper understanding of the discipline

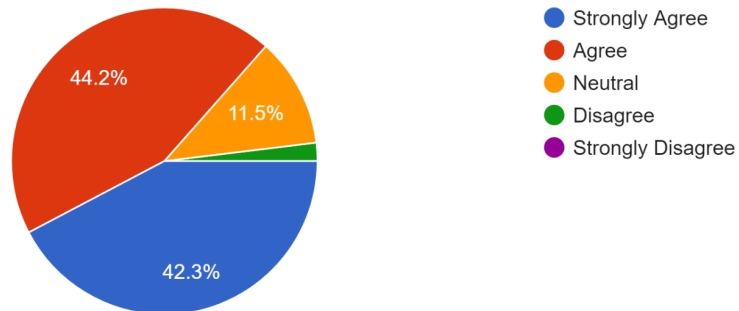
This program helped me to understand the formations of early societies and cultures in the human past

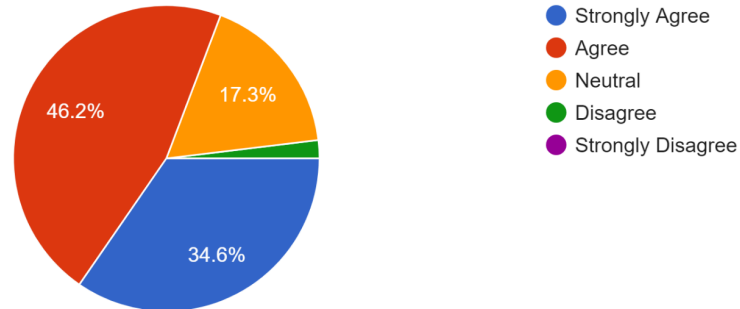
This program helped me to gain a deeper understanding of historical issues which contribute towards the making of the society

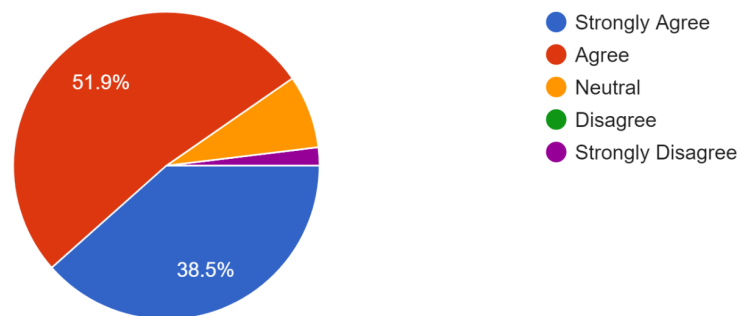
This program helped me to learn to formulate arguments for writings and discussion, based on critical thinking and understanding of historical issues.

Observations

Analysis of students' responses to the questions indicate that the programme has been successful in its endeavour to expand the understanding of students towards Indian and World History. Besides, more than 80% of the students have agreed that they were able to construe the importance of sources and methodology in history. The students have also mentioned that they are able to construct arguments based on critical thinking which reflects the overall positive impact of the programme.

Action Taken Report

For instance, the department will use ICT tools more often. Besides, the department will be encouraging students to pursue research at the UG level in order to allow them direct exposure to the methods and methodology of history.
