


There has been an improvement in my communication skills.











OBSERVATIONS:

In the survey, 70 to 75% of students strongly believed they had achieved the learning outcomes of the program. However, 20% responded neutrally about their communication skills, and 5% felt they had not met the learning outcomes for courses such as GEC and SEC. Overall, students expressed high satisfaction with the program's outcomes.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN:

To stimulate students' minds and encourage independent learning, we will organize additional webinars, conferences, and workshops covering various subjects. Innovative teaching methods such as flipped classrooms and student presentations will be increasingly employed to enhance communication skills and build confidence. Additionally, we will offer more frequent remedial classes for slower learners.
