## **Program-Specific Outcomes**

• Trust in Institutions:

The program enhanced participants' trust in branches of government like the Parliament and Judiciary.

• Interest in Politics:

There was a clear increase in students' interest in Indian politics.

Philosophical Understanding:

Students reported a better grasp of Western and Indian philosophers and their contemporary relevance.

Global Awareness:

Respondents became more aware of global challenges such as climate change, terrorism, pandemics, and nuclear issues.

### **Action Points Based on Feedback**

- 1. Enhance Life Skills Training
  - → Add more workshops and interactive sessions.
- 2. Deepen Political Engagement
  - → Organize debates, mock parliaments, and expert talks.
- 3. Apply Philosophical Concepts
  - → Use case studies to connect philosophy with real issues.
- 4. Expand Global Awareness
  - → Include sessions on climate change, pandemics, etc.
- 5. **Promote Institutional Trust** 
  - → Arrange visits or talks with government officials.
- 6. Improve Feedback Collection
  - → Use better prompts to get more useful suggestions.
- 7. Monitor Attendance
  - → Track trends and consider flexible participation options.
