


There has been an improvement in my communication skills.






This program provided me the ability to understand Sanskrit shastras, i.e., Vedas, Upanisad, Ramayan, Mahabharat, etc. 9 responses






This program trained me in the art of balanced living.

Observations:

More than 60% of the students believed they had successfully achieved the learning outcomes of the program. Similarly, over 60% responded positively regarding the development of their communication skills. A significant number of students also reported having learned the Sanskrit language. Action to be taken:

Based on student feedback, some improvements are needed. We will organize more interactive sessions with activities, workshops, conferences and group discussions covering various Subjects. We will also organise a spoken Sanskrit camp to give more chances to speak and listen in Sanskrit to build communication skills. Remedial classes can help those who find the subject difficult. Cultural events like plays and poetry can make learning fun. Regular feedback from students should be taken to improve the program. More learning materials like books and videos should also be provided. These steps will help make the program better and more effective.
