




I am better equipped to Engage in Critical Thinking 22 responses



There has been Improvement in my communication skills 22 responses




## I am better equipped to engage in more and confident social interactions <sup>22</sup> responses




### I rate myself as a better and an aware citizen






# I understand the issues of environment and sustainable development 22 responses

#### Observations:


Almost all the students said that the program helped them in improving their communication skills and feel more confident in social interactions. The course also helped them in becoming aware citizens and understanding about ethics and values. They were able to understand the issues relating to the environment and sustainable development. Around 95 % of the students were able to engage in critical thinking, gained confidence to interact socially and were equipped with self-direction and life-long learning.




This program gave an introduction to real world economic issues and problems facing the country and the world;




This program provided me the ability to gain an understanding of proper policy responses to economic problems




This program trained me to collect primary data and learn sampling techniques 22 responses




This program helped me learn to use scientific empirical methods to arrive at conclusions about the validity of economic theories




### This program trained me in the art of economic modelling

#### **Observations:**

Almost all the students were able to understand the basic economic concepts and theories. More than 95 % of the students gained the ability to understand policy responses to economic problems. They were trained to collect primary data using sampling techniques. Around 90 % of the students use scientific empirical methods to arrive at conclusions about the validity of economic theories. Majority of the students learned to apply mathematical and statistical techniques in economics. They agreed that they were introduced to real world economic issues and problems facing the country and the world.

#### **Action Taken:**

The Department will organize more Lectures with experts on different fields so that students get different perspectives to economic problems and theories. A tour of either industries or intuitions which related with the discipline such as World Bank, RBI, SEBI, Mother Dairy, etc. This would help students get first hand knowledge about the theories that they study in courses. Conferences and Workshops will be held to motivate students to do independent research projects.
