












Observations:

From the responses, it is observed that 71% of students had more than 67% of attendance, 16.1 % had 50-67% attendance and 12.9% had less than 50% attendance.

At the end of the programme, 94% students agreed that the programme engaged their critical thinking, 90% agreed that the programme improved their communication skills, 87% agreed that their confidence and soft skills improved, 97% students agreed that they were more engaged citizen, 94% agreed that the programme developed their ethics and values, 97% agreed that programme engaged them in issues of environment and sustainable development, and 97% were confident that they were directed to be self sufficient and lifelong learners.

The programme improved 97% students' skill to read and interpret literary texts, 94% students valued creativity and literature because of the programme, 94% students agreed that the programme introduced them to global culture and literature, 90% students agreed that they were now knowledgeable in complex philosophical, literary and cultural concepts, 94% students agreed their writing skills improved and 94% students agreed that the programme helped them realise their creative potential.

The overwhelming feedback has been positive. The negative responses were less than 4% students in every question and less than 4% remained neutral.

Action To Be Taken:

The department will pursue the following measures, to help students gain competence in English communication the department will encourage them to use the Language Lab. Arrange more remedial classes for students who need additional academic support. To give more tutorials to improve writing skills and clear doubts. To help with speaking skills, the department will push for class presentations, group discussions and debates. For better understanding of ideas and concepts interactive classroom shall by used through ICT and smart boards. To ensure higher attendance students will be motivated and be given peer counsel and support.
