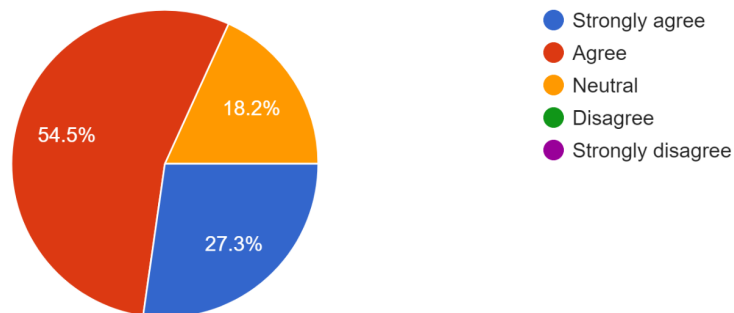

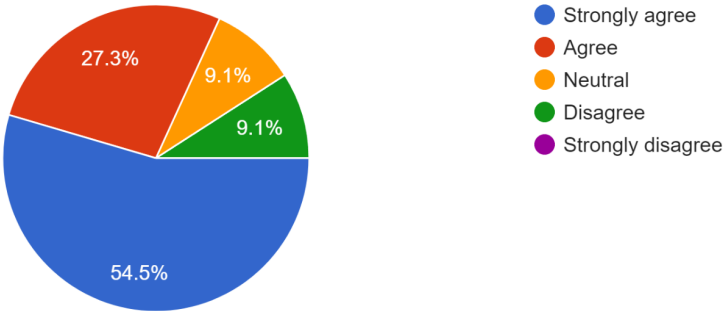
I am better equipped to Engage in Critical Thinking

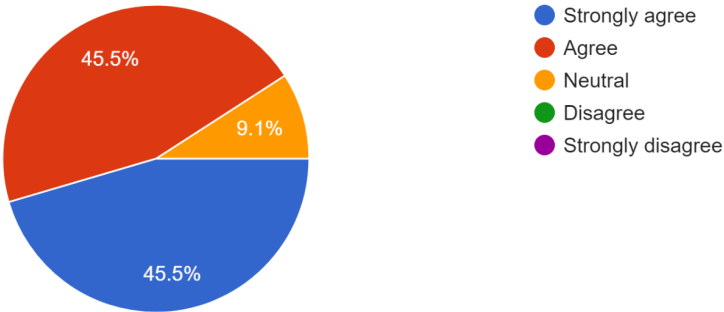
I am better equipped to engage in more and confident social interactions

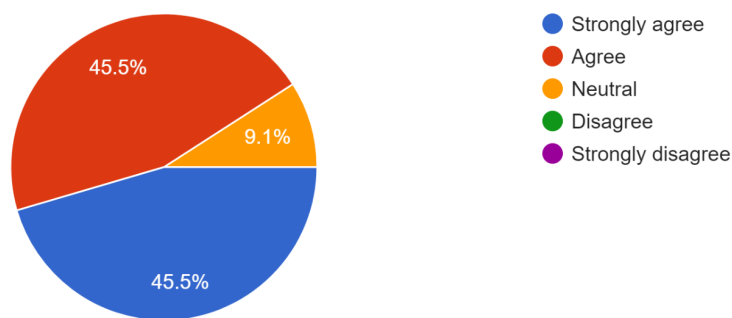
I rate myself as a better and an aware citizen

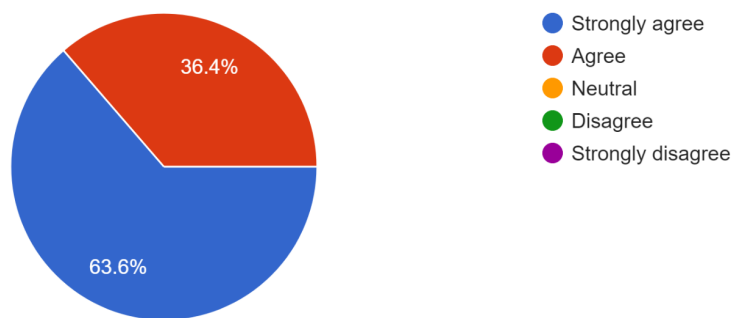
I understand the importance of ethics and values

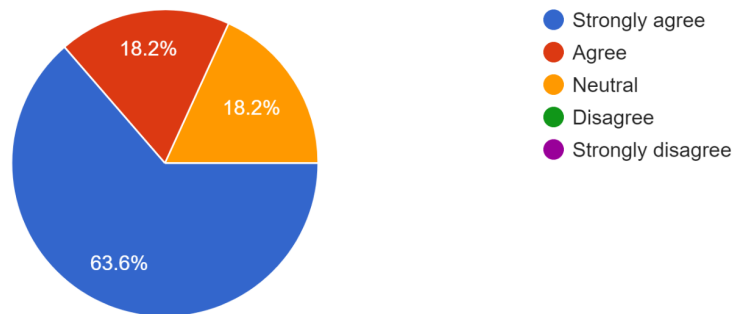
I understand the issues of environment and sustainable development

Observations:

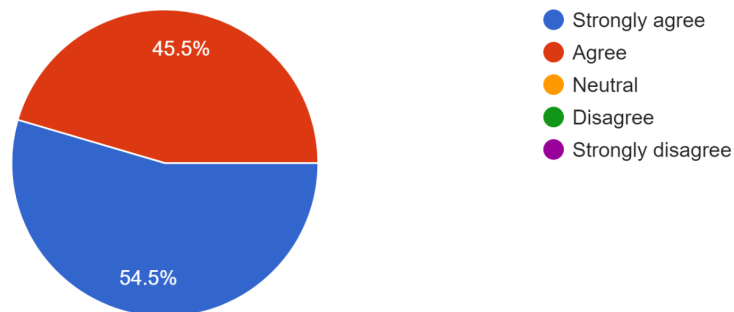
Action Taken Report:

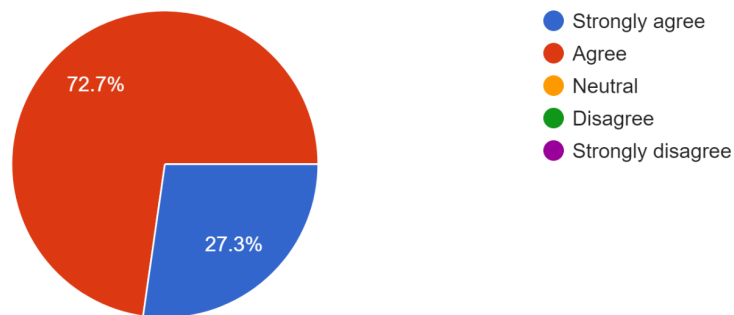
This program helped me to gain an understanding of basic economic theory

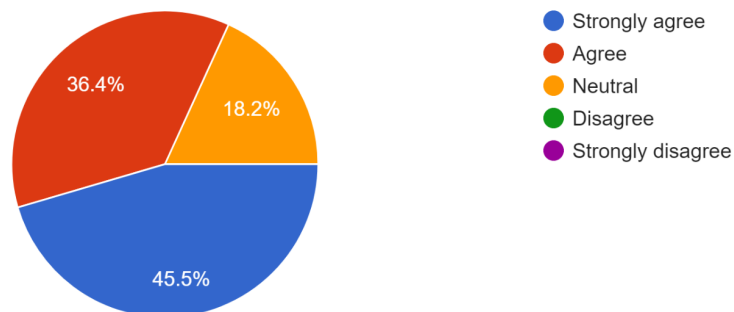
I have learnt the mathematical and statistical techniques necessary for a proper understanding of the discipline

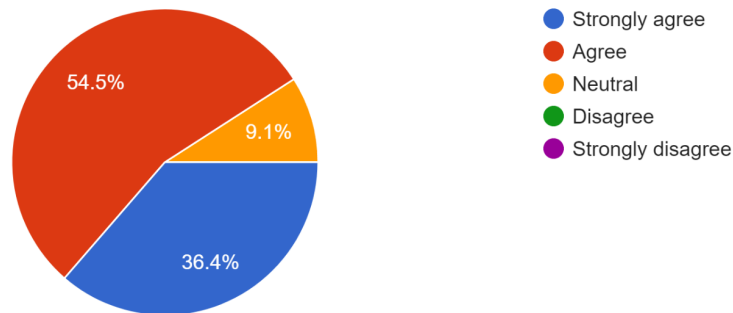
This program gave an introduction to real world economic issues and problems facing the country and the world;

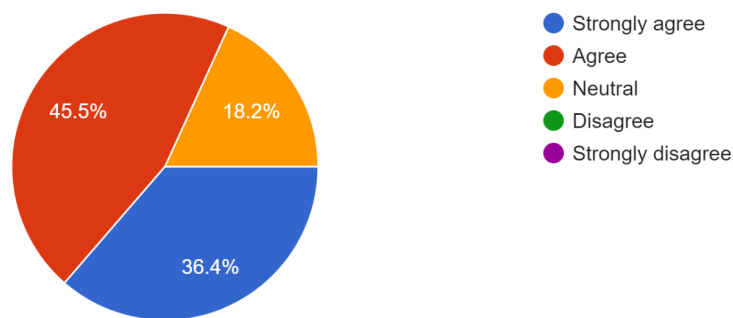
This program provided me the ability to gain an understanding of proper policy responses to economic problems

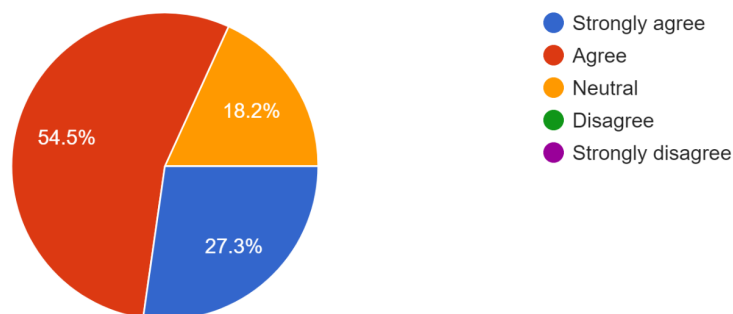
This program trained me to collect primary data and learn sampling techniques

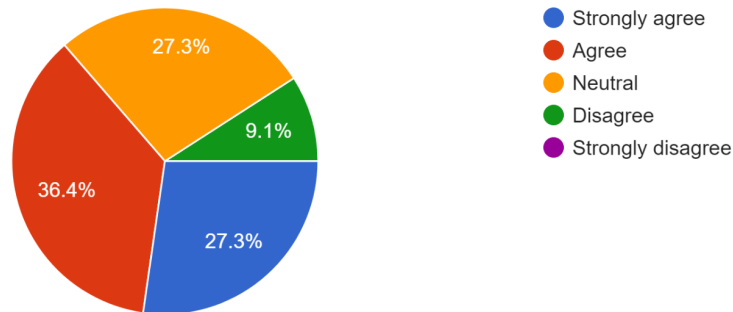
This program helped me learn to use scientific empirical methods to arrive at conclusions about the validity of economic theories

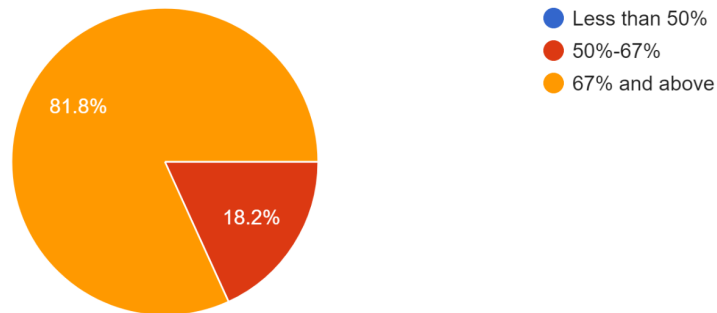
This program trained me in the art of economic modelling

Observations:

Almost all the students were able to understand the basic economic concepts and theories. More than 100% of the students gained the ability to understand policy responses to economic problems. They were trained to collect primary data using sampling techniques. Around 82.5 % of the students use scientific empirical methods to arrive at conclusions about the validity of economic theories. Majority of the students learned to apply mathematical and statistical techniques in economics. They agreed that they were introduced to real world economic issues and problems facing the country and the world.

Action Taken Report:

The Department will organize more Lectures with experts on different fields so that students get different perspectives to economic problems and theories. A tour of either industries or intuitions which related with the discipline such as World Bank, RBI, SEBI, Mother Dairy, Institute of Agricultural Research, etc. This would help students get first hand knowledge about the theories

that they study in courses. Conferences and Workshops will be held to motivate students to do independent research projects.
