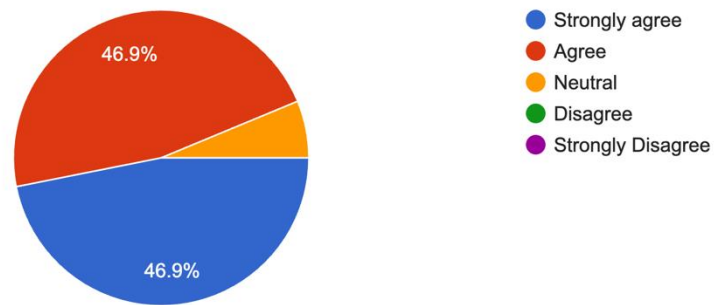


Program Exit Survey For B.A (H) Sociology Batch 2020-2023

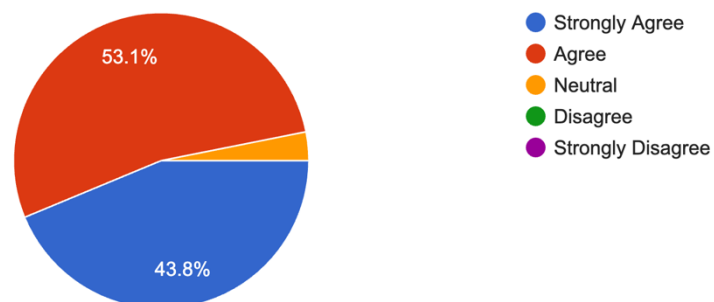
1. B.A. (H) Sociology has exposed graduates to the multiple theoretical perspectives in Sociology.

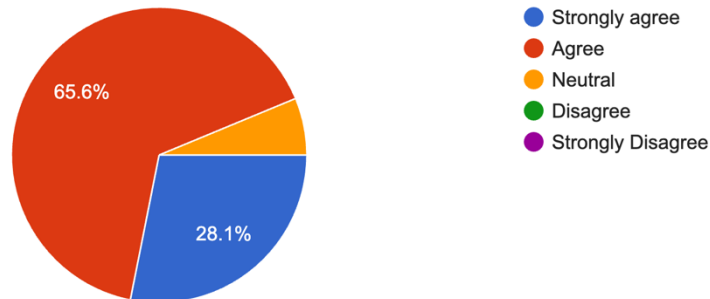
2. The B.A. (H) Sociology program has enabled the graduate to learn that knowledge is socially constructed.

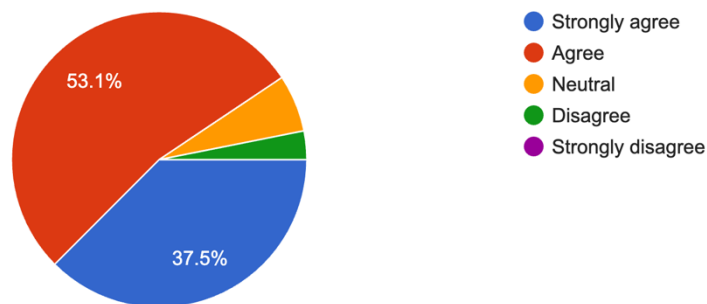
3. The B.A. (H) Sociology program has enabled the graduate to recognise the universal significance of social institutions in society.

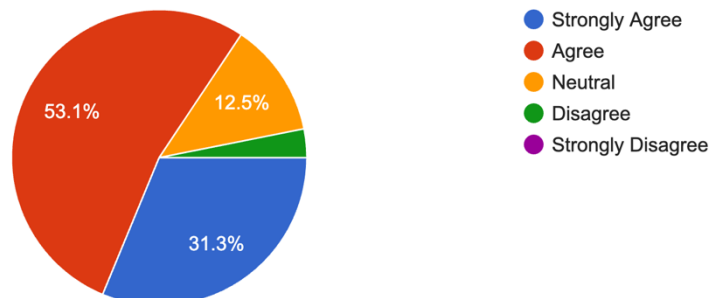
4. The DSE and GE courses have highlighted the significance of the interdisciplinary nature of the courses in Sociology.

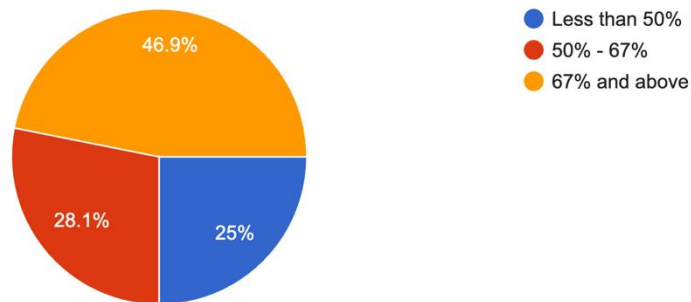
5. The SEC courses have helped in training the graduate with skills in the pursuit of Academics and Ethnographic Film Making.

OBSERVATIONS:

In the survey, 30-45% students strongly felt that they had attained the learning outcomes of the program, whereas 45-65% felt that they had attained the learning outcomes. Some students felt that they had not attained the learning outcomes of courses like GEC and SEC.

Enhanced usage of ICT and student-centric practices in the classroom will facilitate students to fully attain the program learning outcomes.
