

AAMDANI 2017-18

- In late January 2018, FIC organized a paper presentation competition for its members. For the competition 30 contemporary issues from the financial world were chosen. These varied topics gave the members a chance to broaden their horizons regarding the knowledge of economic world and to improve their presentation skills.



- On 13th October, 2017 an elucidating seminar on 'Derivative and International Markets' was organized. The seminar was accompanied by a virtual live trading session in the derivative and foreign exchange markets. The seminar enhanced students' knowledge on forex market application (including forex trading mechanism, domestic vs. international currency, spread, pair currency and data impact) and derivative trading skills (including NSE real market application).



- In early September, the society collaborated with the BSE Institute Ltd. to organize a mock stock event (virtual stock trading) developed by both the parties. On 20th September, 2017 'MOCKSTATION: The BSE Mock Stock' was organized by the society in which 110 teams participated, more than 200 individuals also participated in simultaneous event organized by the society. A virtual stock trading platform was created wherein participant teams traded through public outcry mechanism and the market was partially driven by real market prices and partially by demand and supply of stocks being trades on the virtual platform. Top 5 teams were acknowledged with cash prizes amounting to Rs 15000 and scholarships.



- The year kickstarted with an initiative of celebrating the Financial Literacy Week embarked by the Reserve Bank of India. The cell stepped forward and took endeavor to

propagate financial cognizance through social media. The Financial Literacy campaign focused on imparting knowledge on 4 broad themes viz. Know Your Customer (KYC), Exercising Credit Discipline, Grievance Redressal and Going Digital. The campaign was observed from 5 – 9 June 2017.

- With the onset of the new academic year a series of activities were undertaken commencing with the orientation of the society to the registrations and interviews that led to organization of a team of 30 members for the year 2017-18 including 4 office bearers.
