### **Cricket Bidding League:**

**Aamdani**, the Finance and Investment Cell of Janki Devi Memorial College, organized a Case-Based Learning (CBL) competition as a part of their annual flagship event **Fintastic'25**. The competition took place on **April 4th, 2025**, from **11 AM to 4 PM**, in the **Auditorium** and **Seminar Room**.

The event, titled “**Cricket Bidding League**”, was designed to encourage participants to **compete against the finest, push their limits, and claim their spot as the ultimate champions** in this epic college cricket showdown. Participants were challenged to analyse cricket through the eyes of auctioneers, present well-informed arguments, and contribute meaningful insights.

The competition comprised three rounds:

The competition consisted of three rounds:

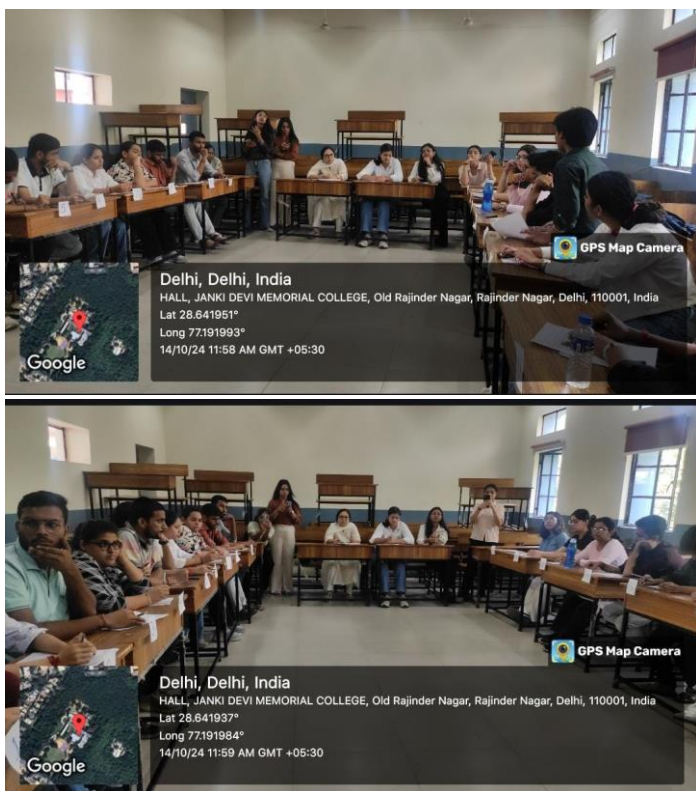
Round 1: Participants were given a sentence to interpret and discuss.
