ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022



The report of the Society from 1st April 2021- 31st March 2022 are as follows:


Puppet Theatre Festival: Anubhuti performed an Experimental Play Badjaat at the closing ceremony of Puppet Theatre Festival: The Largest Campus Puppet Theatre Festival held on 2nd April 2021 by Create Room for Artists in collaboration with Parindey: The Dramatics Society of Mata Sundari College at Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, Janpath, New Delhi. The festival witnessed perfomances from all across India.



Monologues. : A Live Virtual Performance was held on 5th August 2021, on zoom with an audience of 100+. The performances included 8 artists from different parts of the country who beautifully curated a virtual performance that aimed at spreading awareness on menstruation.




Samwaad: Anubhuti: The Dramatics Club of Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi organized Samwaad a Lecture - Demonstration on The Role of Jatras in the Freedom Struggle of India under the banner of Aazaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The lecture was facilitated by Mr. Gourab Ghosh, lecturer at Narsee Monjee Institute of Management Studies. The event was held on 25th September 2021, 6:00 PM on Zoom. Mr. Gourab Ghosh gave an insightful lecture on the topic thus explaining the history of the folk art & its usage as a tool for freedom struggle. The event was graced with the presence of Staff Advisors, Teacher Convenors & the lovely audience.



Adakaari An Inter College Monologue Competition: Anubhuti member Megha Chhayadi bagged the second position at adakaari: an inter college monologue competition organised by New Delhi Institute of Management on 28th February 2021.



The Story Box, is an initiative taken by Anubhuti to revisit the beautiful stories written by some of the famous writers and bring them to life by curating them into beautiful Dramatic Storytelling performances every month. Performed online, the initiative has helped on just the members to evolve in theatrical practices but also helped the audience to be witnesses to some of the beautiful stories written by well known artists. Till now 3 Episodes of The Story Box have been successfully held Online. The dates are as follows: 27th September 2021, 31st October 2021, 28th November 2021.



KALEIDOSCOPE: An Experimental Theatre Workshop & Production, was a 10 days program that was held from 4th October 2021 onwards in offline mode for all the students of Anubhuti:

15 Days Actor Training & Theatre Basics Workshop was held for the selected candidates. The program was held online from 4th January 2022, 5:00 PM Onwards. The program was designed & facilitated by our director Mr. Amit Tiwari.

Tameer'22: The 15 days actor training & theatre basics workshop ended with Tameer where the students performed their self designed & directed monologues using all the techniques, theories & practices they were taught in the 15 days extensive & experiential theatre training course.
