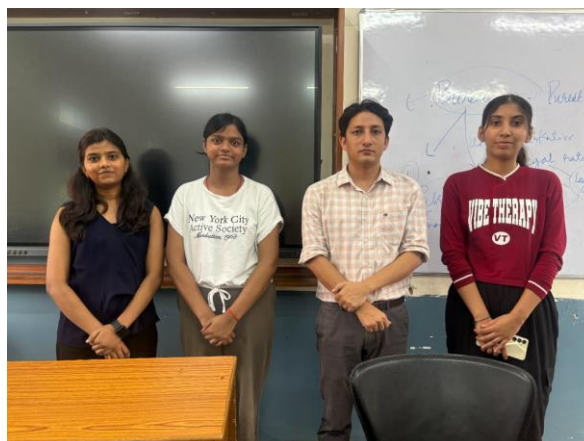
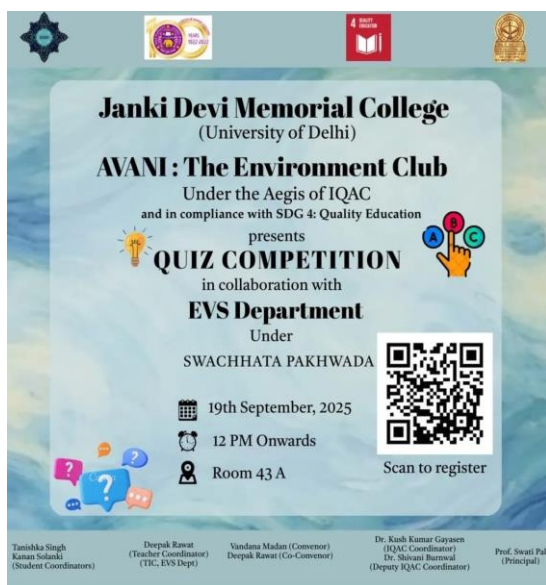


## SWACHHATA PAKHWADA: QUIZ COMPETITION

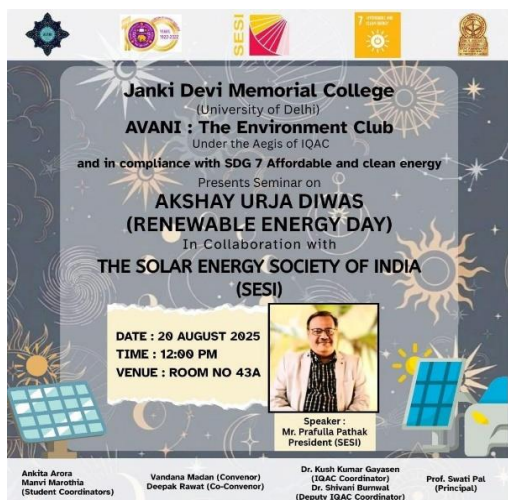


## AKSHYA URJA DIWAS

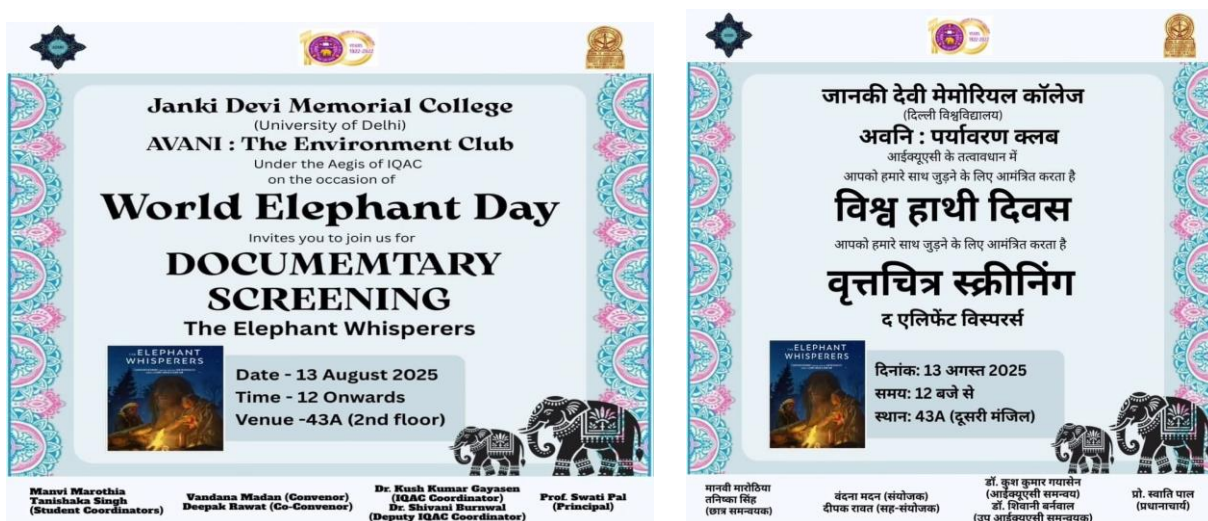


## WORLD ELEPHANT DAY

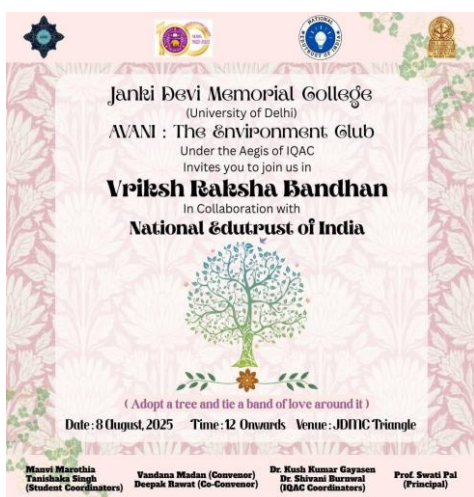




## VRIKSH RAKSHABANDHAN

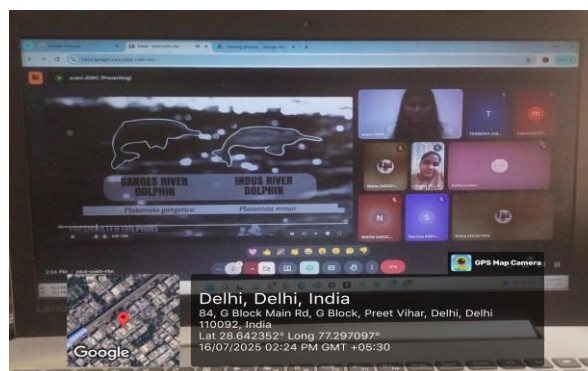
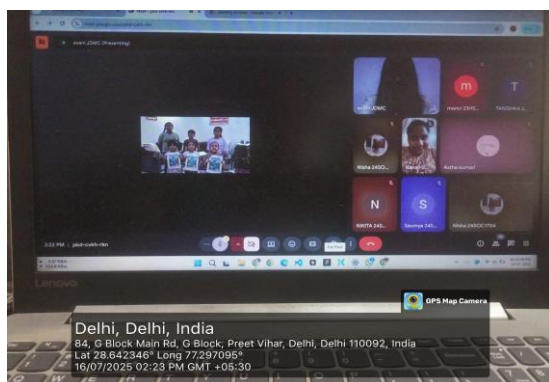
