

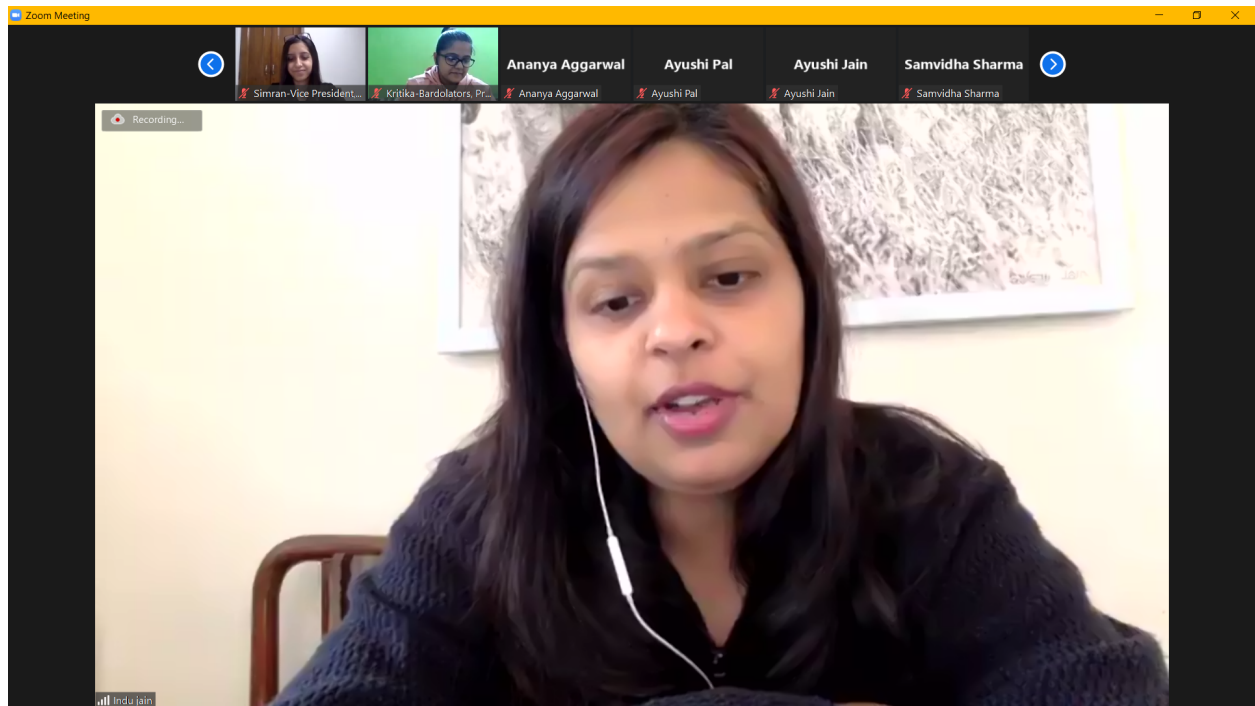

The students were taught various methods to express themselves and a major focus was laid on using the body to express diverse emotions and meaning. Ms. Manna also discussed the importance of utilisation of space during performance, both virtual and physical. Through the workshop, students were introduced to the seven levels of tension, an invaluable method that can

be utilised for understanding and portraying a character on stage. Each day of the workshop concluded with an interactive session, where the students could ask their doubts and seek clarifications. Hence, the workshop was highly beneficial to students and has received a highly positive feedback from them.

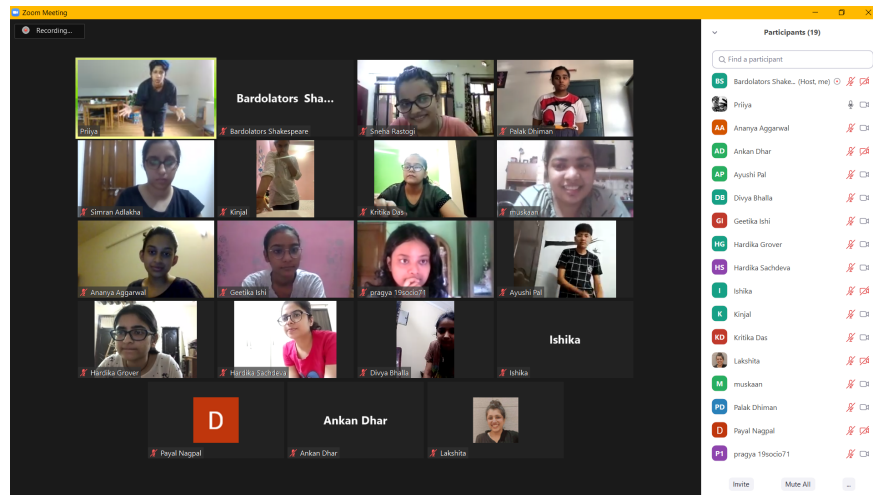
