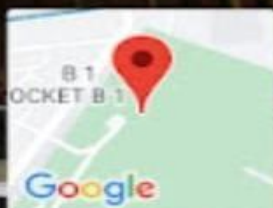
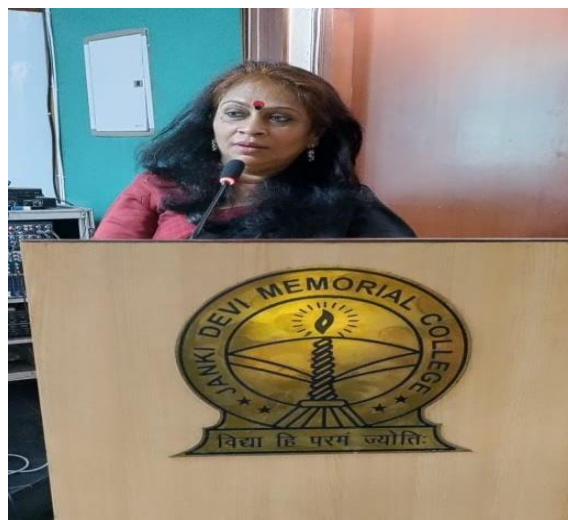

The Spiritual Consciousness Cell "Chetna" and IQAC- centre for universal value and ethics of Janki Devi Memorial College organised a seminar titled "Life beautiful" engulfing the Vision and teachings of Sri Aurobindo on 23rd June, 2022 at 10 am in the Seminar room to commemorate Sri Aurobindo's 150th anniversary. The followers of the Mother and Sri Aurobindo from "Eager to Forge Ahead"- India Trust, who started a unique movement named as 'Janmobhumi to Tapobhumi' to celebrate the 150th Birth Anniversary Sri Aurobindo were invited to deliver the lecture. The session began with meditation followed by a Bhajan. The lecture began with a brief life sketch of Sri Aurobindo. Sri Aurobindo's belief in human divinity was highlighted by the esteemed speakers. The attainment of 'Divya manav' and 'ati manav' considered Sri Aurobindo as the ultimate destination of human beings. In other words, man is in the transitional phase, somewhere lying between animalistic and humanistic core but his ultimate destination is towards divinity. Sri Aurobindo concluded that man is moving towards divinity and will eventually attain that objective. But to attain that divinity having a purpose in life was considered to be the key element by Sri Aurobindo. It was reiterated that pursuit of material assets and lack of purpose in life fails to make us truly happy and content. To manifest the divine should be the purpose of our life. We should identify and nurture our own uniqueness. The lecture was highly enlightening and was attended by 80 students which also included faculty members. The session concluded with meditation and distribution of Prasad by "Eager to Forge Ahead" team.

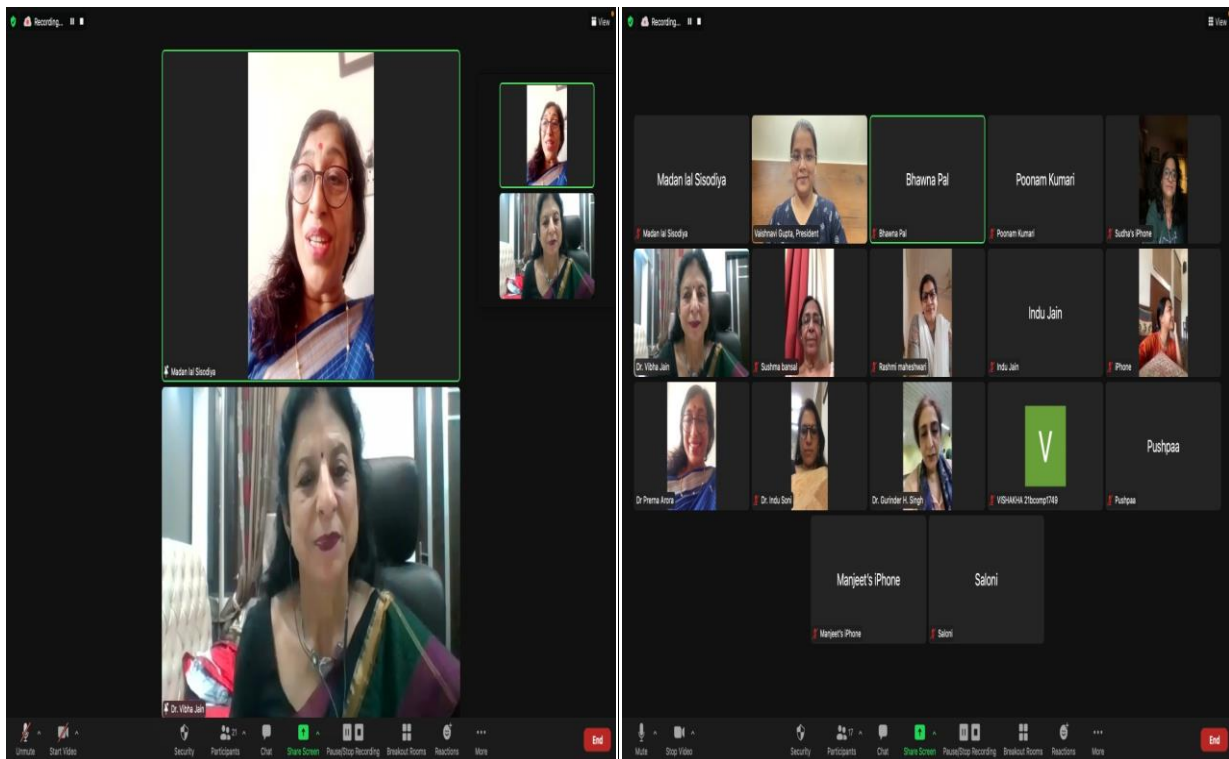

Chetna: The Spiritual Consciousness Cell and IQAC- Centre for Universal Values and Ethics of Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi organised a National webinar on “Religion and Morality: Perspectives from Guru Nanak’s Bani” on 20th April, 2022 at 11.40 am on Zoom handle. The esteemed speaker was Prof. Paramveer Singh, Professor Harbans Singh Department of Encyclopaedia of Sikhism, Punjabi University, Patiala. The esteemed speaker in his lecture highlighted the basic tenets of Sikh religion through the words of Guru Nanak enshrined in Gurbani. Prof. Paramveer Singh posited that religion is a medium to connect with the supreme power. Adherence to religion with desire for rewards is not genuine pursuit of religion. He further appraised that Guru Nanak did not distinguish between Hindus or Muslims. He considered all human beings, irrespective of their religion as children of God, who Guru Nanak reiterated in Gurbani, must prioritize becoming good Hindus or good Muslims, in essence good human beings who see and treat everyone equally. Mutual love and brotherhood will only get promoted and vices such as jealousy will be eliminated only when everyone connects to God. The lecture was highly captivating and enlightening. It reintroduced the audience with the foundational principles of Sikhism and the importance of connecting with the supreme power which is all the more relevant in today’s time. The webinar concluded with a formal vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Prerna Arora.

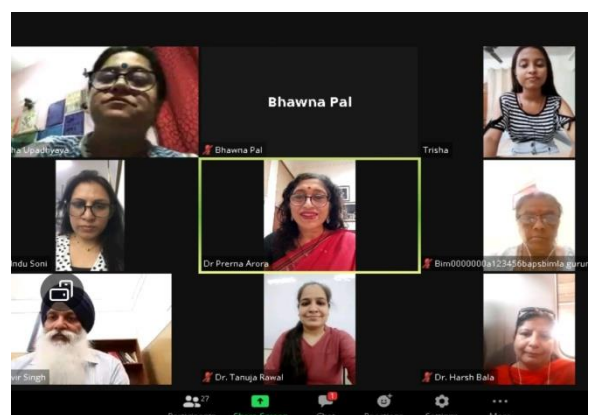
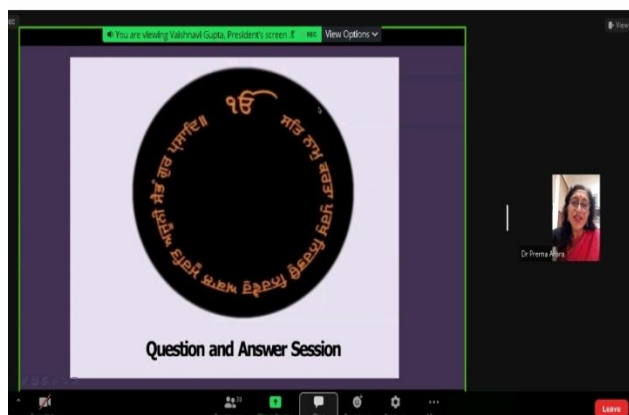

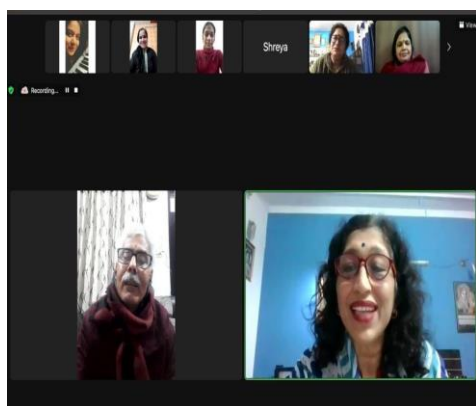

Chetna Society of Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi organised a webinar titled “Makarsankranti, Lohri and Pongal” to celebrate the auspicious festivals of Makarsankranti, Lohri and Pongal on 14th January, 2022 at 3.30 pm on Zoom platform. The webinar was attended by 77 participant which included students and faculty members across University of Delhi. Acharya Haridev Shastri from Sankrit Bharti graced the occasion as distinguished speaker of this webinar. The program began with college prayer and chanting of Sanskrit Shloka by Acharya ji, who began his lecture with a discussion on the importance of festivals in Indian culture. He called these festivals as “blood of the nation”. He distinguished between *Utsava* and *Parva* and reiterated the significance of *Parva* in bringing the people together as part of community. 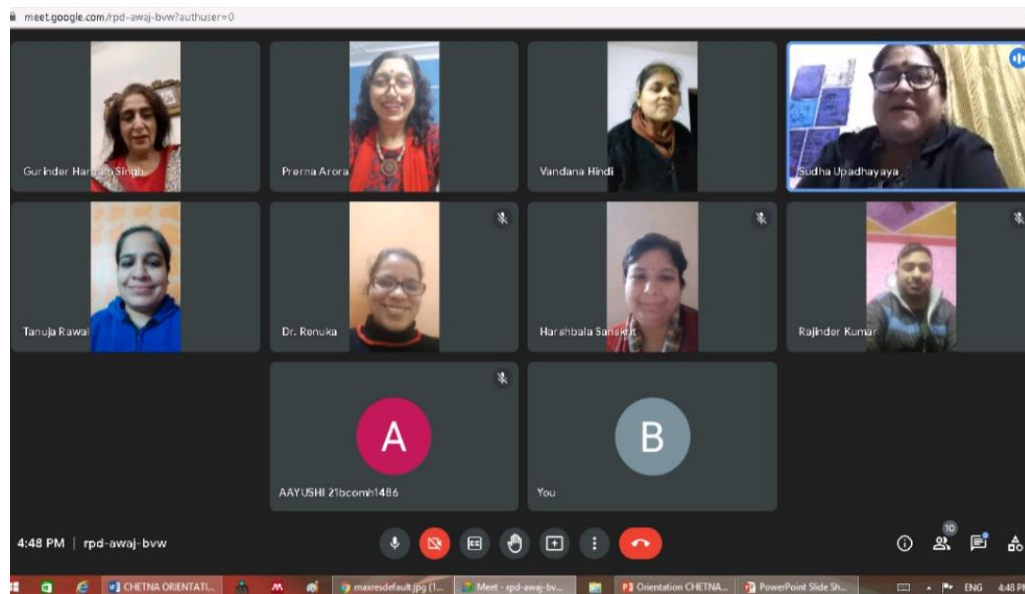
Event – Orientation Session

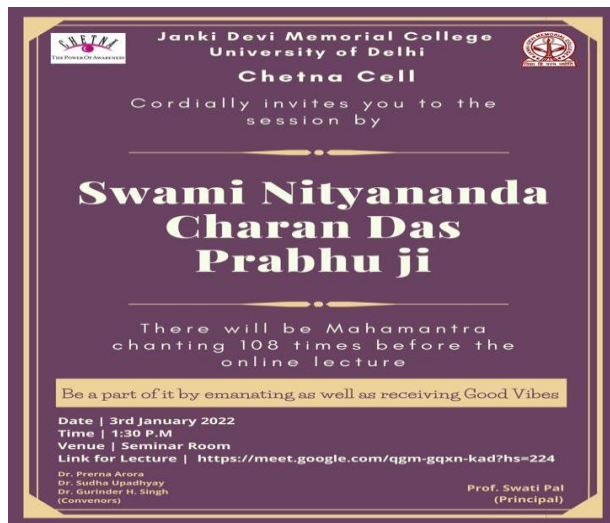
Speaker – Swami Nityananda Charan Das Prabhu ji (on screen)

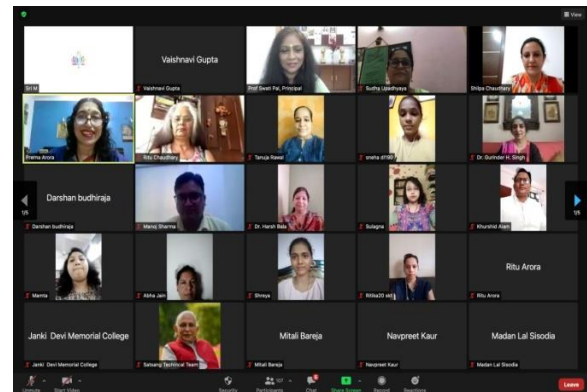
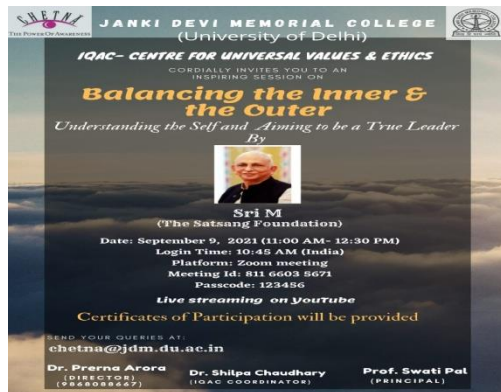
