Moreover, the team heads briefed the students about their respective duties in the team. The energetic goodwill and hope for the good in hard times fulfilled everyone with positive energy.




# SEMINAR ON WINNING CAREER SKILLS DATE: 16<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2023

# SEMINAR ON WINNING CAREER SKILLS DATE: 17<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2023


"When you look for a symbiotic relationship and end up with a future in finance." is when you need guidance and mentorship to move ahead in the direction of achievement in such a competitive field.


