Report of Majlis 2023

Etihad, the MUN society of Janki Devi Memorial College, hosted the third edition of its annual MUN conference event 'MAJLIS' on 12th and 13th of April, 2023. It was a two day event filled with experience, learning, joy, and thrill. The conference was comprised of two committees: G20 (the International committee) and AIPPM (the Indian committee). Both of them witnessed eager participation from delegates of different backgrounds and institutions.

The event kicked off with the Opening Ceremony at 10, with the inaugural speech delivered by the Secretariats welcoming our esteemed principal Prof. Swati Pal, chief guest Prof. Sunanda Bharti and the distinguished delegates.

G20 (Group Of Twenty) :

The agenda of this committee was 'Post covid economic recovery with special focus on building intergovernmental resilience for future time of crisis'.

The committee began with the introduction of the Executive Board, Mr. Shivam Gupta and Ms. Awstika Das. The conference began by the delivery of opening speeches from the delegates, who each represented a member of the G20. The delegates went on to discuss some of the major topics surrounding the issue of the economic loss that the whole world had to suffer due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Their ideas and speeches

included every major detail about the overall effects, problems and solutions regarding the agenda. Some sub-agendas that were brought up in the committee included 'Economic empowerment through employment and job creation', 'Strengthening multilateral emergency response with special emphasis on future possibilities of pandemic' and 'Solutions pertaining to the agenda'. The delegates produced an authentic draft paper by the end of the event and successfully concluded the committee.

AIPPM (All India Political Party Meet) :

The agenda of this committee was 'Deliberation upon the Union budget with special emphasis on cryptocurrency regulation'. The committee began with the introduction of the Executive Board, Mr. Shivansh Srivastava and Mr. Rutajeet Karmakar. The various topics that were brought up and discussed upon included the pros and cons of cryptocurrency, its effects on various sectors and groups of people, effects on infrastructure and investment, and solutions for the problems arising in the modern financial landscape. The committee was brought to a successful end by the delegates through a concluding draft paper.

At last, the closing ceremony took place where the results were announced and all the participants were congratulated for their brilliantly thrilling performance. Ms. Jaya Yadav, the teacher coordinator, took the initiative to enunciate the efforts of the entire team of

It was a one-day committee that witnessed the participation of some of the best speakers who came together for a powerful and engaging debate.

The event started with the opening ceremony at 09:00 a.m. with the inaugural speech delivered by the secretariat welcoming our esteemed principal Prof. Swati Pal, chief guest Ms. Gayatri Sharma, the teacher convenors, the Executive Board, and all the distinguished delegates. Prof. Swati Pal expressed her delight and delivered words of encouragement for the organising team and the delegates. Report of G20 University Connect Finale

The Government of India organized the G20 University Connect Finale on 26th of September 2023 at Bharat Mandapam where G20 summit took place. It was a one-day event where several universities participated from Delhi NCR. This event witnessed the participation of many renowned speakers including, Shri Narendra Modi, Shri S. Jaishankar, Shri Amitabh Kant, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan and other G20 panelists.

A total of 57 students participated from the college for this remarkable event, out of which 24 were from the MUN society Etihad while 33 were from the NCC unit.

After reporting to JLN stadium, students got their registrations done and collected their kits that included a t-shirt, booklets, pen & notepad, and a carry bag. This was followed by the lunch, and then students left for the most awaited destination of the day, Bharat Mandapam at 1:30 PM. At 3 PM after the various phases of verification, the event started at Bharat Mandapam with great enthusiasm and excitement. The G20 Indian panelists initiated the event with individual speeches, followed by the speech given by Sherpa of G20, Shri Amitabh Kant. He addressed the students on various topics including the rapid progress of India in the last couple of years. He expressed his opinions about technology and also gave the relevant example of UPI, that has made it easy to make payments within a fraction of seconds.

The Foreign Minister of India, Shri S. Jaishankar kept the event engaging by highlighting some of the latest events and shared his vision for future prospects with the students. It was truly enlightening to verbally understand the model of India in the coming decades. And, with the arrival of the Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi ji at 4:07 PM, his speech came to an end. Students and teachers from various universities, welcomed the Prime Minister of India with a huge round of applause and excitement. The Education Minister of India, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan gave a very concise and thoughtful speech to welcome the Prime Minister of

India. Shri Narendra Modi ji started his speech at 4:21 PM, with the unveiling of 4 new books in the honour of successful execution of the G20 summit. He kept his speech really engaging for the young minds and shared a deep insight over the past 30 days of G20 summit. He shared various ideas, achievements and plans with the students with a special focus on the coming 25 years of India. The highlights of his speech included the insights over 85 meetings that took place in the past 30 days, 1.15 lakh jobs given to unemployed people, and last but not the least, the bill for the women's development that got 100% majority in New Parliament building and has become an international headline. In the words of Honorable Prime Minister himself, "The decisions that took place in the G20 summit in India, with the collaboration and mutual agreement of other countries, have the capacity to change the entire direction of 21st century." And with this, he took his leave at 5:10 PM, with the concluding words on "vocal for local" and "India as a developed country in next 25 years".

The enthusiasm of students remained intact till the very last minute, that filled the auditorium with the patriotic slogans of "Bharat Mata ki JAI!" The students left the Bharat Mandapam not just with dreams, but with the visuals of turning their dreams into reality.

Mr. Aditya Jha, the chairperson for UNHRC, is a young enthusiast and an exceptional debater with keen interest in Indian politics and international affairs. 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Report of Entente 4.0

The two-day event was filled with experience, learning, and fun. The conference comprised of two committees: UNHRC (the International committee) and Lok Sabha (the Indian committee). Both of the committees witnessed eager participation from delegates of our institute.

To help the delegates in understanding the proceedings of the conference, a training session was conducted with the Executive Board on 31st October, 2023 from 12:00 – 02:00 p.m. in the Seminar Room. During the session, Mr. Rajat Sharma and Mr. Aditya Jha, serving as the EB for Lok Sabha and UNHRC respectively, thoroughly explained the rules of proceeding and other important information like the significance of lobbying and its working, procedure for documentation and the various

points that are to be raised by the delegates in the committee. The session came to an end with a fun round of quiz and all the delegates got good wishes from the EB for their performance in the conference.

- UNHRC (United Nations Human Rights Council) –

The UNHRC committee witnessed the participation of a total of 30 delegates. The agenda of the committee was ‘Addressing human rights violations in the Israel – Palestine conflict : A call to action for Justice and Accountability’. Mr. Aditya Jha and Ms. Alishka Sagar served as the Executive Board for the committee. Mr. Jha is currently pursuing B.Tech from Delhi Technological University. He has an experience of more than 6 years in the national and international MUN circuit. Ms. Sagar is a B.Com student in Janki Devi Memorial College, DU. Her experience in MUNs spans 5 years, and she strongly believes in the positive impact that MUNs have on students.

The committee began with the introduction of the EB, followed by a quick recap of the rules and proceedings of the committee. The speeches began from the GSL (General Speakers List), and went on throughout the various sections of the committee like the PSL (Provisional Speakers List), moderated caucus and unmoderated caucus. The main sub-agendas discussed by the delegates in the committee were Breach of War laws, Violence against vulnerable groups during

conflicts, and the impact of the ongoing war crisis on global economy.

By the end of the conference, the committee was divided mainly into three groups – those supporting Palestine, those supporting Israel, and those who have a neutral stance on the overall situation. Lastly, an unmoderated session took place for the working paper and the delegates were required to give solutions pertaining to the agenda.

- LOK SABHA –

The Lok Sabha committee had a total of 27 delegates representing various politicians in the Indian politics. The agenda for this committee was ‘Fostering Peace and Development : Addressing the conflicts and challenges in North – east India with special emphasis on Manipur’. The Executive Board comprised two members, Mr. Rajat Sharma and Ms. Mehak Gupta. Mr. Sharma is currently perusing B.A. Economics (Hons.) from Hansraj College, DU. He has participated in more than 85 MUNs and Youth Parliaments. Ms. Gupta is a final year student of B.A. Pol. Sci. (Hons.) in Janki Devi Memorial College, DU. With three years of MUN experience as both a delegate and an Executive Board member, she embodies commitment, and believes that MUNs nurture confidence and public speaking skills.

The committee began with the introduction of the EB. The delegates started the debate and quickly began the

teamwork of coordinating with the other politicians of their political party. The committee witnessed some highly interactive public and private sessions, where the political leaders brought their best game to the table for an aggressive and heated debate.

The committee saw various topics being debated upon by the members, such as the lack of ministers from the ruling party being present in Manipur during crisis, conditions of schools and institutes in Delhi, riots during the Indian National Congress's rule, etc. A discussion on the humanitarian crisis in Manipur took the center stage, while other areas being covered included the conditions of unemployment and education sector in Manipur.
