

Quizonics: The Freshers' Quiz

The first event of the session was Quizonics: The Freshers Quiz, held on 4 September 2025. The event was hosted by Anyuta Shahi with Rashmi Jain serving as the quiz master for the mains round.

27 teams participated in the quiz with great enthusiasm and curiosity. After a close set of rounds, Ranveer Pratap Singh and Parth Sarthi Singh from Hansraj College secured the first position.
