
National Cadet Corps – Annual Report 2020 - 2021

 Cpl. Aditi Mishra grabbed consolation prize for slogan presenting competition on the occasion of Kargil diwas.







HEROES'. The occasion was graced by Lt. Cdr. Bijay Nair(retd).






NCC cadets of Janki Devi Memorial College celebrated International Plastic Bag




• JDMC NCC organised the digital creativity workshop from 1st -7th June 2021. The main aim of the workshop was to polish the skills of digital literacy of the cadets.






JDMC NCC Cadets celebrate INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA from 12th to 21st
