followed by a Yoga Session on 2nd day, which included chief guest- Hemant Brijwasi on 7th April, 2022.


On 8th April, 2022, the event concluded with a Closing Ceremony speech by Ranjit Chaturvedi and chief guest R P Singh and Shankaracharya.




- NCC cadets of Janki Devi memorial college celebrated A Happy and Green Diwali (4th Nov 2021), keeping it a sustainable celebration.







1. **2nd year - B certificate**
