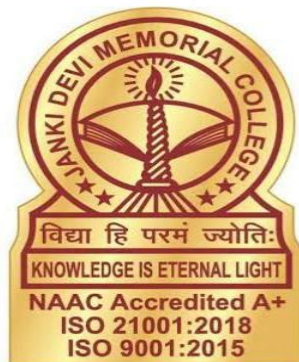

The North Eastern Students’ Group of Janki Devi Memorial College organized an open discussion on ‘Indigeneity, Indigenous Identity, and Nupi Maanbi’ on April 4, 2025, in Room No. 66 from 12 to 1 PM.

The esteemed speaker for the event was Pavel Sagolsem, co-founder of The Chinky Homo Project, an initiative that documents the lived experiences of queer individuals from Northeast India.

The discussion aimed to explore the themes of Indigeneity, Indigenous identity, and the lived experiences of Nupi Maanbi - transgender individuals from Manipur who are reclaiming their voices and space in

society. The focus was on fostering empathy, challenging stereotypes, and building a more inclusive understanding of Indigenous and queer identities.
