#### **Nyishi Tribe Dance Workshop**



#### Report



#### Report

On 24th September 2025, the North East Students' Group of Janki Devi Memorial College organised "Seraphim", its monthly movie screening event. The programme began at 3:00 PM in Room No. 43A and brought together students and faculty for an afternoon of films that explored diverse cultural and social themes from different parts of India.

The screening opened with *Borme* (2022), an award-winning Tagin short film directed by Tapen Natam. The film traced how seemingly small actions can lead to larger consequences, while also offering a vivid portrayal of the heritage of Arunachal Pradesh, its traditions, and its breathtaking natural landscapes. Following this, the audience was shown *Between the Silence* (2018), a powerful film from Nagaland produced by the State Legal Services Authority. This narrative focused on the struggles of a married woman and her child in an abusive household, underlining the urgent need to break the silence around domestic violence. The final screening of the evening was *Nasjal (The Pilgrimage)* (2025), directed by Iftikhar Hussain. Set against the backdrop of Ladakh, this moving story followed a father's pilgrimage with his son, beautifully capturing themes of parental love, sacrifice, devotion, and the enduring bond between a parent and child.

After the screenings, an engaging discussion unfolded among the students and teachers present. The dialogue created a space for meaningful reflection on the cultural and emotional depth of the films, while also drawing attention to the social issues they highlighted. Viewers shared thoughtful feedback, and the exchange of perspectives made the session both enriching and memorable.

#### **NESG Orientation Day**






